Cemeteries Act 1958 RULES AND REGULATIONS

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the Cemeteries Act the Trustees of Williamstown Public Cemetery hereby make the following Regulation which shall come into operation upon publication in the Government Gazette: General Information:

The Trust has developed a Section within the Cemetery which is referred to as a Monumental Lawn area. This Section has reinforced concrete beams which have been installed by the Trust. Beam size per allotment is:

Single Beam 600 mm wide \times 1220 mm long Double Beam 1050 mm wide \times 1220 mm long

Material to be used:

All monuments and markers should be of first quality natural stone, attached ornaments or symbols to be of ceramic, brass, copper, fibre glass or stainless steel.

Memorial Specifications:

Base Stone 1070 mm long \times 380 mm wide \times 150 mm high

(Single Beam)—Base stone to be positioned centre of beam

(Double Beam)—Base stone to be positioned with rear of stone to centre of beam.

Back of each base stone to be fixed on a common line. Rear of base stones on double beam to be sawn, butt joined and grouted. It is the Masons responsibility to make sure the dimensions of the base stones are the same in this instance. The bottom of every base stone should be dressed to an even bed so that it will stand plumb, resting firmly and level on the beam.

Provision for Floral Tributes:

Base stone to provide for at least one flower container, minimum size (circular) 75 mm diameter \times 100 mm deep—(rectangular) 200 mm long \times 75 mm wide \times 75 mm deep.

Headstone Height and Thickness Ratio:

Height including base stone to 760 mm minimum thickness 75 mm.

Height including base stone to 920 mm minimum thickness 100 mm.

Height including base stone to 1200 mm minimum thickness 150 mm.

When a religious figure or similar item is to be mounted on H/S the H/S thickness to be not less than base size of said item.

All Headstones mounted to show a 50 mm margin from rear of base, and a 50 mm minimum margin from the ends of the base stone.

All rears faces of headstones to be fixed on a common line.

Tolerance in Dimension:

10 mm variation allowed on all dimensions, except on headstone thickness where 70 mm

minimum is for specified 75 mm and 95 mm minimum for specified 100 mm and 145 mm minimum for specified 150 mm and on lengths of base stone which must match on double beam. Dowel Holes:

Two dowels of 10 mm or 15 mm diam. in each H/S and base combination.

Dowels to be of approved material e.g., Copper, Bronze or Stainless Steel.

Dowel Hole Positions (Base to Beam)

- (1) Follow on to H/S dowel holes, in which case the dowels would be 300 mm long.
- (2) Or on different centres to H/S dowels, in which case the dowels would be 150 mm long (75 into each stone).

Application for Monumental Work:

Monumental work shall not be commenced until plans and specifications have been approved by the Trustees. All applications must be in writing and shall include:

- (a) Detailed drawing of the proposed monument which clearly indicates style, size of all material and any inscription to be placed thereon.
- (b) The written consent of the Holder of the Right of Burial or other person authorised on his or her behalf.
- (c) The appropriate fees as prescribed by the Trustees.

Written approval shall be presented to the Cemetery Foreman prior to commencement of site works.

Height of Memorial:

Minimum height of a memorial, 760 mm including base stone.

Maximum height of memorial, 1200 mm including base stone.

Numbering:

All monuments must include a grave number on the front left hand corner of the base stone.

Letters to be approximately 15 mm in size.

Trade Marks:

If a Trade Name is to be included on a memorial it must be fixed to the base stone on the right front corner.

Letters to be approximately 15 mm in size. Prohibited Material:

Memorials of cement, artificial stone, brick, composition wood, tin or iron will not be permitted.

 - 3. No person shall-
 - (a) enter or remain in the Reserve who may offend against decency as regards dress, language or conduct;
 - (b) commit any nuisance in the Reserve;
 - (c) climb or jump over the gates or fences in or around the Reserve, stick bills thereon, or cut names on or in any way damage or injure any of the buildings, gates, fences or seats in the Reserve, nor leave or deposit any glass, paper, rubbish or other unwanted material or thing in the Reserve except in receptacles provided for the purpose;
 - (d) light any fires in the Reserve except in any place or places which may be provided for the purpose by the Committee;
 - (e) remove any sand, soil, gravel or rock from the Reserve;
 - (f) damage any vegetation or interfere with or disturb any sand, stone, gravel, rock, clay or other earth by driving any vehicle or by any other means;

- (g) drive any vehicle in a manner dangerous to the public;
- (h) drive any vehicle so as to cause noise which is unreasonable in the circumstances.
- 4. No person, unless authorised in writing and then only subject to such terms, fees and conditions as may be prescribed by the Committee, shall—
 - (a) set up or occupy within the Reserve a camp or caravan;
 - (b) bring into the Reserve any dog unless such dog is and continues to be at all times controlled by a chain or leash and any dog found in the Reserve except as provided shall be seized and disposed of by the Committee:
 - (c) bring into the Reserve any horses, cattle, sheep, pigs, goats or other animals;
 - (d) sell or offer for sale in the Reserve any article or any commodity whatsoever;
 - (e) organise or take part in any public entertainment, game or sport in the Reserve;
 - (f) in the Reserve carry a firearm of any description or any weapon or instrument capable of discharging a missile, shoot at, or kill or injure any animal, bird or other wildlife; provided that subject to the provisions of the Game Act 1958, the holder of a current game licence legally in pursuit of wild ducks during the open season for such ducks may—
 - (i) use a shot gun as defined under the Game Act 1958; and
 - (ii) carry a shot gun during the twentyfour (24) hour period immediately prior to said open season.











NOTICE OF SPECIAL PERMITS ISSUED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC AUTHORITY UNDER THE COUNCIL GRAIN PERMIT SCHEME

The Road Traffic Authority has issued special permits under section 35 of the *Motor Car Act* 1958 in accordance with the Council Grain Permit Scheme to enable certain vehicles to exceed the prescribed mass limits in section 33 of the Act. The conditions of the permit are as follows:

- 1. The permit extends from 24 November 1987 to 31 March 1988;
- 2. travel is limited to:
- (a) State Highways, Main Roads and Freeways (declared in accordance with the Transport Act 1983); and

- 5. the vehicle does not travel on a bridge or road if the gross mass of the vehicle and load exceeds the limit shown on a notice erected on the approaches to the bridge or road;
