State Electricity Commission Act 1958
TARIFFS AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS
OF SUPPLY

Pursuant to the sixth schedule of the *State Electricity Commission Act 1958*, notice of the tariffs and terms and conditions upon which the State Electricity Commission of Victoria supplies electricity to customers was given by special gazette dated 30 June 1988. Clause A5.3 of that notice referring to Efficient Energy Based Industry Tariff (P) and clause A6.1 referring to Standby Supply Tariff (S) indicated that given rates were subject to price escalation which will be retrospectively applied from 1 July 1988 when official cost and price indices were available.

Notice is hereby given that the following revised rates will apply to electricity supplied under Efficient Energy Based Industry Tariff (P) and Standby Supply Tariffs—Option 3 (S3):

Efficient Energy Based Industry Tariff P

Available for supplies at 220 kV and higher voltages only, for contract periods of not less than 20 years. Other contractual terms by negotiation will include minimum contract demand requirements and provision for price escalation; and may include credit for interruptible supply.

Energy Price: 1.121 c/kWh

Demand Price: 16.21 \$/kW/Billing Period

These prices do not include the cost of provision of dedicated supply plant.

Standby Supply Tariff:—Option 3

Available for supply at 220, 330 or 500 kV.

Standby Demand Price: 1.80 \$/kW/Billing Period

Energy Prices: Peak Periods (7 am to 11 pm, Monday to Friday) 6.839 c/kWh

Off-peak Periods (All times outside peak periods) 3.387 c/kWh
