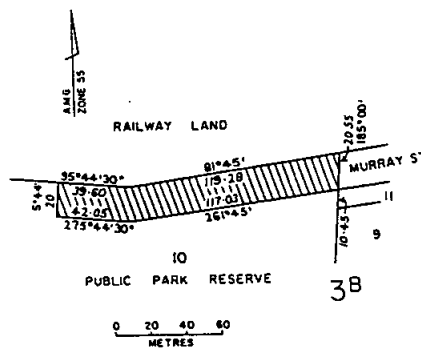

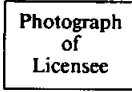

(ii) does not intend to practise as an employee of another solicitor;
