4 Per Cent Second Tier—Notice of Proposed Award Variation

Following the State Wage Case Decision of 7 March 1988, notice is hereby given that the Federated Liquor and Allied Industries Employees Union of Australia (Victorian Branch) has applied for the decision of Deputy President Keogh, Australian Conciliation and Arbitration Commission (Print H.0121), regarding the Federal Metal Industry Award for a wage increase of 4 per cent, to flow to the Canteen Workers Award.
