*Forests Act 1958, No. 6254*  
REVOCATION OF PROHIBITED PERIOD

In pursuance of the powers conferred by section 3 of the *Forests Act 1958* I, Kay Setches, Her Majesty's Minister for Conservation, Forests and Lands in the State of Victoria, hereby vary the Declarations of a Prohibited Period previously made by me in the *Victoria Government Gazette* No. 40 dated 19 October 1988, No. S 87 dated 2 November 1988, No. 45 dated 23 November 1988, No. 47 dated 7 December 1988, No. 48 dated 14 December 1988 and No. 49 dated 21 December 1988 insofar as they refer to the municipalities specified hereunder, and by this notice declare that in the specified municipalities the Prohibited Period in respect to any fire protected area (other than a State forest, National park or protected public land) shall end as specified hereunder.

Schedule 1

The Prohibited Period shall end at midnight between Sunday, 2 and Monday, 3 April 1989 in the following municipalities:

The Borough of Sebastopol.

The Cities of Ararat, Ballarat and Maryborough.

The Rural City of Wodonga.

The United Shire of Beechworth.

The Shires of Alberton, Arapiles, Ararat, Avoca, Avon, Buln Buln, Ballarat, Bungaree, Buninyong, Bairnsdale, Benalla, Bright, Creswick, Chiltern, Colac, Eitham, Euroa, Grenville, Healesville, Heytesbury, Leigh, Lexton, Mansfield, Maffra, Mirboo, Morwell, Myrtleford, Narracan, Ormeo, Orbost, Otway, Oxley, Pakenham, Ripon, Rosedale, Stawell, South Gippsland, Talbot and Clunes, Tallangatta, Tambo, Traralgon, Tullaroop, Upper Murray, Upper Yarra, Violet Town, Wangarratta, Warragul, Wimmera, Winchelsea, Woorayl and Yackandandah.

Schedule 2

The Prohibited Period shall end at midnight between Wednesday, 5 and Thursday, 6 April 1989 in the following municipality:

The Shire of Dundas.

Schedule 3

The Prohibited Period shall end at midnight between Friday, 7 and Saturday, 8 April 1989 in the following municipalities:

The Shires of Heywood, Glenelg, Minnamite and Wannan.

Schedule 4

The Prohibited Period shall end at midnight between Sunday, 9 and Monday, 10 April 1989 in the following municipality:

The Shire of Kowree.
