CITY OF CAMBERWELL

By-law 216

A By-law of the City of Camberwell made under sections 197 (1) and 200A of the *Local Government Act 1958* (as amended), and numbered 216 for the purpose of suppressing nuisances, for the purpose of preserving public decency, for the purpose of providing for the health of the residents in the municipal district and against the spreading of contagious or infectious diseases; and for maintaining the good rule and government of the municipality.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1958* (as amended), the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Camberwell order as follows:

No person shall conduct, keep or operate a brothel within the City of Camberwell without a permit in writing pursuant to this By-law from the Council of the City of Camberwell.

Operation

This By-law No. 216 shall apply to and have operation throughout the whole of the Municipal district of the City of Camberwell and shall come into operation and have effect the day after its publication in the *Victoria Government Gazette*.

Resolution for passing this By-law agreed to by the Council of the City of Camberwell, 17 July 1989; and confirmed 28 August 1989.

CITY OF CAMBERWELL

By-law 217

A By-law of the City of Camberwell made under section 197 (1) (XXVII) (A) of the *Local Government Act 1958* (as amended), and numbered 217 the purpose of prescribing a portion of the municipality as a business area and providing that the use of any building or portion of any building for the purpose of a brothel within such area is prohibited.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1958* (as amended), the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Camberwell order as follows:

That the area abutting Canterbury Road to a depth of 50 metres to the north thereof between Balwyn Road and Union Road, Canterbury is hereby prescribed as a business area and the use of any building or portion of any building for the purpose of a brothel within such area is hereby prohibited.

Operation

This By-law No. 217 shall apply to and have operation throughout the whole of the Municipal district of the City of Camberwell and shall come into operation and have effect the day after its publication in the *Victoria Government Gazette*.

Resolution for passing this By-law agreed to by the Council of the City of Camberwell, 7 August 1989; and confirmed 28 August 1989.
