By-Law No. 6132

Amending By-Law No. 6056 as Amended by
By-Laws No. 6103 and 6105 for Regulating,
Shooting on Commission Property During the
Declared Open Season for Shooting of Wild
Ducks

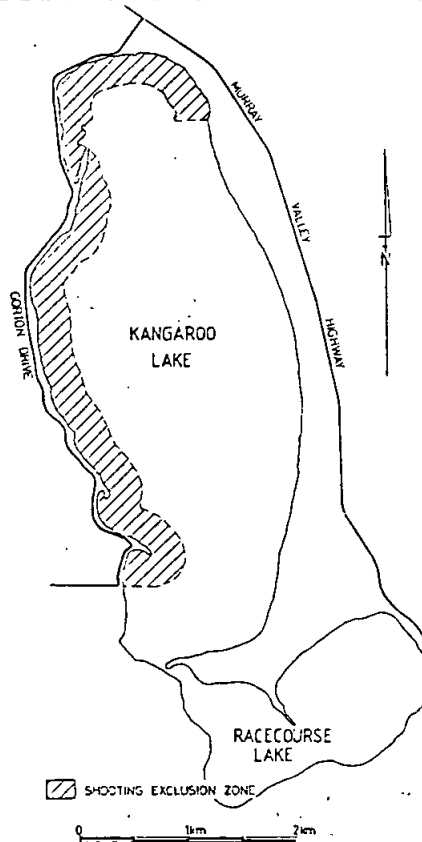
The Rural Water Commission of Victoria
(hereinafter called "the Commission"), pursuant
to the provisions of the *Water Act* 1958 and all
other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes
the following By-Law:

By-Law No. 6056 made by the Commission
on 20 February 1986 (and amended by By-Law
No. 6103 made by the Commission on 24
February 1988, and By-Law No. 6105 made by
the Commission on 15 June 1988), is hereby
amended as follows:

1. In Schedule 1—

For "Kerang Lakes—Lake Charm, Lake
Little Charm, Kangaroo Lake, Lake
Tutchewop, Racecourse Lake" there shall
be substituted the following:

"Kerang Lakes—Lake Charm, Lake Little
Charm, Lake Tutchewop, Racecourse Lake
and Kangaroo Lake (except that section of
the Lake being 300 metres from the shore
in the north-east area adjacent to Gorton
Drive along the northern and western shores
of the Lake as indicated by the hatching on
the plan in Schedule 3)".
