By-Law No. 254: Water Supply Notice of Preparation of a Regulatory Impact Statement

In accordance with the provisions of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1962, notice is given of the proposal to make By-law No. 254: Water

The proposed By-law amends By-law No. 218: Water Supply by increasing the charges for water supplied by measure over 150 kilolitres to residential properties for the 1990-91 financial year.

To offset these increases in water-by-measure charges and to ensure that total water revenue does not increase in real terms the Board proposes to "freeze" the water rate for the 1989-90 and 1990-91 financial years.

The objectives of the proposed statutory rule are-

- (a) to ensure that domestic water users have greater control over their water bill by reducing the proportion payable by way of water rates and increasing the proportion payable by way of water-bymeasure (pay-for-use) charges; and
- (b) to obviate the waste and misuse of water by a pricing system that reduces the rate of growth of household consumption, encourages conservation, and reflects the cost of providing water to customers.

The Regulatory Impact Statement concludes that the proposed By-law is the most appropriate means of achieving these objectives.




