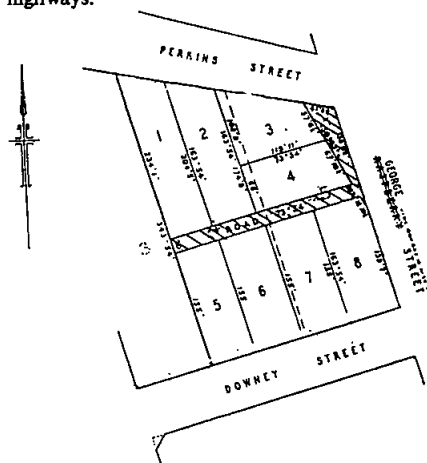

MELBOURNE AND METROPOLITAN BOARD OF WORKS

Notice Declaring that Existing Watercourses within the Cities of Sunshine and Werribee and within the Metropolis shall be Main Drains

Pursuant to section 263 of the *Melbourne and Metropolitan Board of Works Act 1958*, the Melbourne and Metropolitan Board of Works hereby declares that the existing watercourses (or portions thereof) within the Metropolis described in Parts I to IV inclusive of the Schedule hereto shall be main drains under and for the purposes of the said Act.

THE SCHEDULE

The following is a description of the courses of and a specification of the points of commencement and termination of the existing watercourses. The co-ordinates are based on Australian Map Grid Zone 55.

Part I

Commencing at a culvert under Pipe Road approximately 320 m east of the eastern building line of Hume Road and with co-ordinates of N 5 811170 and E 3066290; thence from the culvert in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 100 m; thence in a north-west-

direction to a culvert under Hume Road approximately 280 m north of the northern building line of Pipe Road; thence continuing in a northerly direction along the western building line of Hume Road for approximately 400 m; thence in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 270 m; thence in a northerly direction crossing Boundary Road approximately 730 m east of the eastern building line of Fitzgerald Road; thence in a north-westerly direction for approximately 220 m to a junction with a tributary watercourse known as Derrimut Drain, hereinafter referred to as junction point "A"; thence in the same direction for approximately 180 m to a junction with a tributary watercourse known as Thornhills Drain, hereinafter referred to as junction point "B"; thence continuing in the same direction for approximately 840 m to a culvert under Fitzgerald Road approximately 550 m south of the southern building line of Middle Road; thence through the culvert and in a north-westerly direction for approximately 210 m; thence continuing in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 300 m; thence crossing Middle Road approximately 270 m west of the western building line of Fitzgerald Road; thence continuing from the culvert at Middle Road north-north-westerly for approximately 600 m; thence in a north-westerly direction for approximately 720 m; thence in a westerly direction for approximately 670 m to a culvert under Station Road approximately 510 m south of the southern building line of Riding Boundary Road; thence continuing in the same direction for approximately 430 m; thence continuing in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 300 m; thence in a northerly direction for approximately 300 m to a culvert under Riding Boundary Road approximately 620 m west of the western building line of Station Road; thence continuing in a north-north-easterly direction for approximately 650 m and terminating at a point on the southern building line of the Railways with co-ordinates of N 5 816420 and E 303320.

Part II

Commencing at the aforesaid junction point "A" thence extending generally north-north-easterly for approximately 410 m; thence continuing in a north-easterly direction for approximately 540 m; thence continuing in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 450 m and terminating at that point with co-ordinates of N5 813920 and E 306000.

Part III

Commencing at the aforesaid junction point "B", thence extending in a westerly direction and

crossing under Fitzgerald Road approximately 300 m north of the northern building line of Boundary Road; thence continuing in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 330 m and terminating at a point along the northern boundary of CA 6 bounded by Fitzgerald Road and Boundary Road with co-ordinates of N 812948 and E 304890.

Part IV

Commencing at the end part of the constructed 1800 mm drain along Raymond Road with co-ordinates N 5 811820 and E 306915; thence continuing in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 460 m and crossing Boundary Road at a point approximately 600 m east of the eastern building line of Hume Road; thence continuing in a northerly direction for approximately 600 m and terminating at that point with co-ordinates of N 5 812680 and E 306670.

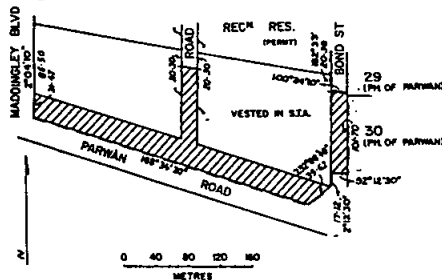

Hawkers and Itinerant Traders By-Law

A By-law of the Shire of Alexandra made under section 197 (1) (xxxiii) and (xxxiv) of the *Local Government Act 1958* and numbered 63:

- (a) Regulating the use of streets, roads and public places by street hawkers and itinerant traders dealing in goods;
- (b) Prohibiting the sale of goods, without a permit under this By-law, from stalls,

motor cars, carts, trucks, barrows, boxes, baskets, crates, bags or other vehicles or receptacles standing or placed on any street, road or public place within the areas described in the First Schedule;

- (c) Prohibiting the sale of goods, without a permit under this By-law, from stalls, motor cars, carts, trucks, barrows or any other vehicles, boxes, baskets, crates, bags or other vehicles or receptacles and standing or placed on vacant land (not being Crown land or land under the care and management of the municipality or a place within the meaning of section 3 of the *Summary Offences Act 1966*) or land which is not ordinarily occupied by the seller of the goods within the areas described in the First Schedule;
- (d) Appointing stands in streets, roads and public places for such street hawkers and itinerant traders and limiting the time during which any such stands may be utilised.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1958* the President, Councillors and Ratepayers of the Shire of Alexandra order as follows:

1. This By-law shall be known as the Hawkers and Itinerant Traders By-law.

2. By-law No. 27 of the Shire of Alexandra and By-law No. 50 of the Shire of Healesville are hereby repealed.

3. In this By-law the following words shall have the meaning ascribed to them unless the contrary intention appears:

"Council" means the Council of the Shire of Alexandra.

"Municipal district" means the municipal district of the Shire of Alexandra.

"Public place" has the same meaning as in section 3 of the *Summary Offences Act 1966*.

"Street hawker" means a person who sells or offers for sale goods which are carried about on the person or in any movable conveyance in any street, road, public place or vacant land in the municipal district and includes an itinerant trader.

"Vacant land" does not include Crown land, land under the care and management of the municipality or a public place within the meaning of section 3 of the *Summary Offences Act 1966*.

"Vehicle" means a stall, motor vehicle, cart, truck, barrow or other vehicle.

4. This By-law shall apply to and have operation throughout the areas described in the First Schedule.

5. No street hawker may use any of the streets or roads or any public place within the area described in the First Schedule for the sale of or any dealings in goods unless a permit has been issued by the Council of the Shire of Alexandra, in accordance with Clause 8 hereof.

6. No person shall sell goods from any vehicle or other receptacle standing or placed on vacant land or land which is not ordinarily occupied by the seller of the goods within any area described in the First Schedule unless a permit has been issued by the Council of the Shire of Alexandra in accordance with Clause 8 or 9 hereof.

7. Any person may apply for a permit under this By-law. The application shall be in the form of the Second Schedule and shall specify:

- (a) The name and address of the applicant;
- (b) The nature of the vehicle or receptacle (if any) which he or she wishes to use;
- (c) If privately owned land which is not owned by the applicants included in the application, the name and address of the owner, evidence of the ownership if the alleged owner is not recorded in Council's rate records as such, and a letter or other evidence of the owner's consent to the application;
- (d) The location of the place where the applicant wishes to sell or trade in goods, by reference to a plan sufficiently identifying the place; and
- (e) Details of the days and hours at which it is proposed to trade.

8. The Council may, at its discretion, grant a permit sought, with or without conditions, or may refuse to grant a permit.

9. Notwithstanding the provision of Clause 8, Council may, at its discretion, grant permits without fee to approved charitable, service or sporting organisations and such permits shall remain in force until cancelled by Council.

10. A permit fee of \$2.50 per day (or part thereof) of operation of an applicant shall be paid, providing that the minimum fee payable for a permit shall be \$10.00, save for those applications made and permits issued under Clause 9.

11. A permit granted in accordance with Clause 8 shall be for the period as specified by Council but shall not exceed 12 months.

12. Any permit issued under this By-law shall be issued to the applicant and shall not be transferable to any other person.

13. A person to whom a permit has been issued under this By-law must have the permit available at all times while he or she is exercising rights under the permit, and shall produce it for

inspection, if requested to do so by a Council Officer or a member of the Police Force.

14. A person who fails to comply with the conditions of a permit issued by this By-law is guilty of an offence against this By-law.

15. Any person guilty of any wilful act or default contrary to this By-law shall be liable to—

- (i) a penalty of not less than one or more than 10 penalty units for a first offence;
- (ii) in the case of a continuing offence, a penalty or not more than one penalty unit for each day on which an offence is continued after conviction or order by a court.

16. In addition to any penalty incurred under Clause 14, any expenses incurred by the Council in consequence of a breach of this By-law by any person shall be paid by that person.

17. This By-law shall come into operation on the day after the date of publication of notice of its making in the *Government Gazette*.

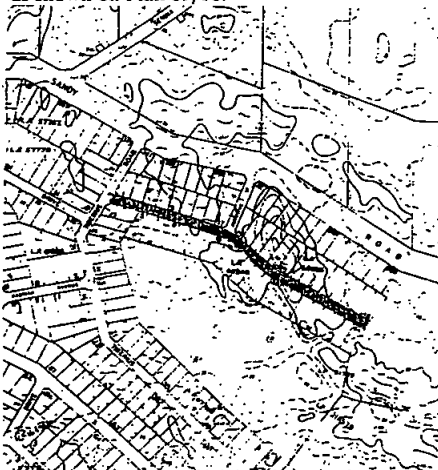

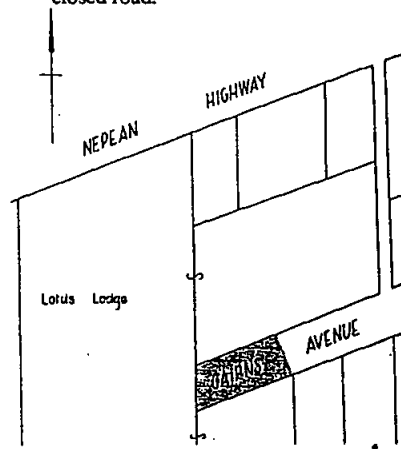

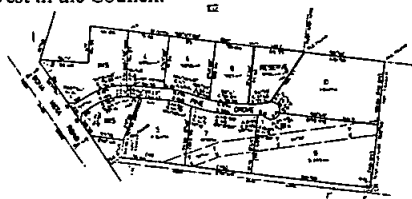
