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GOVERNMENT NOTICES

DAIRY INDUSTRY ACT 1984

In accordance with the provisions of the *Dairy Industry Act 1984*, the Victorian Dairy Industry Authority does, by this notice:

(1) revoke on the specified day the declaration contained in paragraph (3) of the determinations of the Victorian Dairy Industry Authority published in the *Government Gazette* dated 30 November 1988 declaring certain municipal districts (and parts of municipal districts) to be Milk Districts for the purpose of section 33 of the *Dairy Industry Act 1984*;

(2) revoke on the specified day the specification contained in paragraph (4) of the determination of the Victorian Dairy Industry Authority published in the *Government Gazette* dated 30 November 1988 specifying the dairies which may sell or distribute, within Milk Districts, milk for the purpose of human consumption as a liquid other than:

- (a) flavoured milk;
- (b) ultra-heat treat milk;
- (c) milk sold, or to be used, to a canteen conducted at a work place by or on behalf of an employer primarily for the use of its employees or to a canteen conducted at a hospital or school;

(3) declare that, as from the specified day, the municipal districts (and parts of municipal districts) specified in the First Schedule of this notice are to be Milk Districts for the purposes of section 33 of the *Dairy Industry Act 1984*;

(4) specify in the Second Schedule the dairies which may sell or distribute, within the Milk Districts specified in the First Schedule, milk for the purpose of human consumption as a liquid other than:

- (a) flavoured milk;
- (b) ultra-heat treated milk;
- (c) milk sold, or to be used, to a canteen conducted at a work place by or on behalf of any employer primarily for the use of its employees or to a canteen conducted at a hospital or school;

(5) determine that, as from the specified day, any milk processor may sell or distribute market milk to any dairy located in Victoria;

(6) declare that for the purpose of this notice the "specified day" shall be the day upon which the determinations made pursuant to paragraph 4 of this notice shall come into effect by virtue of section 42 (2) of the *Dairy Industry Act 1984*.

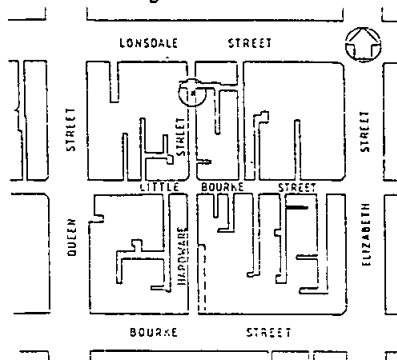

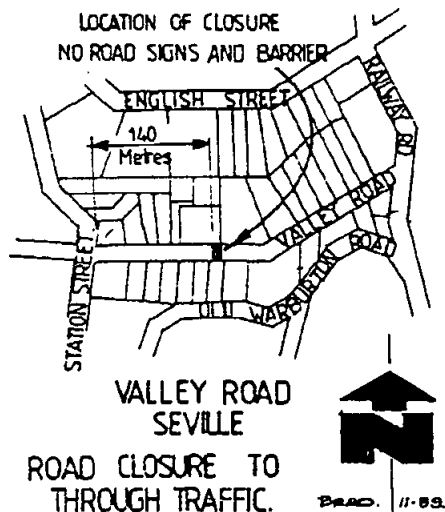

Accident Compensation Act 1985

CHANGES TO PRESCRIBED RATE OF INTEREST

Proposed Amendments to the Accident Compensation Regulations 1985

It is proposed to prescribe from 1 January 1990 a rate of interest to apply in certain circumstances to determinations of amounts to be contributed

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to the costs of WorkCare claims where prior insurers approved under the *Workers Compensation Act 1958* bear part of the liability to meet those claims.

The proposed regulations aim to deter amounts of contribution being set at unreasonable levels and delays in payment of contributions once they have been determined.

It is intended to fix the same rate of interest as applies at present to other provisions of the *Accident Compensation Act 1985*. Accordingly, 20 per cent per year compound will be prescribed as the applicable rate of interest.

A Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared as required by the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1962*. The Statement concludes that the benefits from implementing the measures justify the making of the amendments to the regulations.
