Variation to the Route of a Pipeline

I, David Ronald White, Minister for Industry and Economic Planning for the State of Victoria, hereby give notice in accordance with the provisions of section 12 of the *Pipelines Act* 1967, No. 7541, that the route of the pipeline for which Permit No. 94 to own and use, has been granted by me to Esso Australia Ltd, is varied as follows:

Deletion of the expression—"thence crossing the mouth of Stony Creek via the existing combined rail and pipe bridge passing under the West Gate Bridge to a point opposite the northeastern corner of the junction of Simbock Avenue and Douglas Parade, City of Williamstown and adjacent to petroleum industry Cage F," and

Substituting in lieu the expression—"thence crossing the mouth of Stony Creek via the existing combined rail and pipe bridge passing under the West Gate Bridge to a point opposite the north-eastern corner of the junction of Simcock Avenue and Douglas Parade, City of Williamstown and adjacent to Petroleum Industry Cage F, from which Cage two "jumpers" of approximately 8 metres total length and 250 mm diameter are installed to join the pipeline to the two pipelines authorised under Permit Nos. 37 and 55," and as more particularly shown on Esso Australia
