Now therefore I, J. Davis McCaughey, Governor of Victoria acting with the advice of the Executive Council and under Part II of the *Local Government Act* 1958 and section 4 (2) of the *Local Government Act* 1989, proclaim the municipal district of the Town of Bairnsdale to be a City under the name of the "City of Bairnsdale" with effect on and from 14 July 1990.

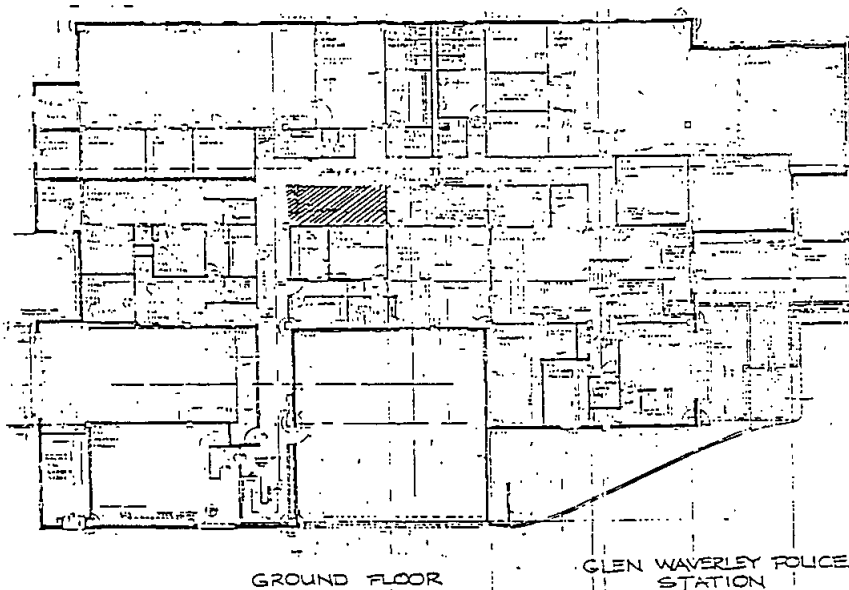

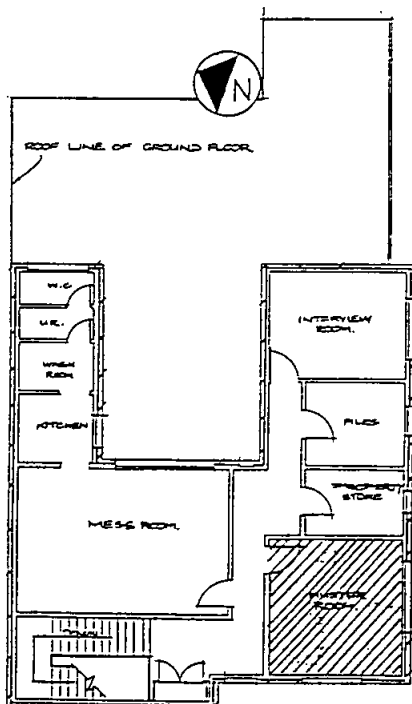
