Standard Conditions For Supply of Electricity

The Standard Conditions For Supply of Electricity under which supply is made available shall be those notified in the *Victoria Government Gazette* No. G12 of 21 March 1990 save and except for the following additions to Section 4, Electricity Accounts:

4.10 Where an applicable tariff rate is changed during a billing period, the electricity supplied and measured by an electricity meter, or estimated to have been supplied, shall be assumed to have been supplied at a uniform daily rate for the whole of the billing period.

4.11 The method of calculating the charge where a tariff rate is altered during a billing period shall be in accordance with the following:

- (a) Calculate the charge for the whole of the billing period as if the prices and methods of charge in force at the commencement of the billing period had not been varied;
- (b) Calculate the charge for the whole of the billing period as if the prices and methods of charge as set out in the altered Schedule of Electricity Prices had been in force for the whole of the billing period;

- (c) Calculate the total actual number of days in the billing period;
- (d) Calculate the number of days from the date of the meter reading immediately preceding the effective date of the tariff alteration to the date immediately prior to the effective date of the tariff alteration, inclusive;
- (e) Divide the charge obtained in (a) by the days obtained from (c) and multiply the result by the number of days obtained in (d);
- (f) Calculate the number of days from (and including) the effective date of the tariff alteration to the date of the next meter reading immediately following the tariff alteration;
- (g) Divide the result obtained in (b) by the number of days obtained from (c) and multiply the result by the number of days obtained from (f);
- (h) The actual bill for the billing period will be the sum of the calculated charges from (e) and (g).
