SPECIAL REGULATIONS FOR THE CARE, PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT OF "ALBERT PARK" IN THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICTS OF SOUTH MELBOURNE AND ST. KILDA

I, Steven Marshall Crabb, Her Majesty's Minister for Conservation and Environment for the State of Victoria, under the powers conferred on me by section 13 of the *Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978*, do hereby make the following Regulations for or with respect to the remaining portion of land in the Municipal Districts of South Melbourne and St. Kilda permanently reserved for a Public Park by Order in Council of 21 March 1876 (*vide Government Gazette* dated 24 March 1876) and hereinafter referred to as the "Reserve".

The Reserve has been placed under the control of a Committee of Management (hereinafter referred to as the "Committee") with full power and authority to enforce these Regulations.

Regulations

1. On 26 January 1991 between the hours of 12 midday and 12 midnight, a person must not—

(a) enter or remain in the Reserve if the person is drunk; or

(b) in the Reserve, consume, or have in possession or under control liquor, except liquor obtained by that person from licensed premises in the Reserve and in accordance with the terms of the licence.

2. The Committee of Management or its servant or agent or any authorised officer or any member of the Police Force may refuse admission to Albert Park Reserve, or remove from Albert Park Reserve, a person if the Committee of Management or its servant or agent or any authorised officer or any member of the Police Force believes on reasonable grounds that the person has committed or is attempting to commit contravention of regulation 1 or an offence under the *Liquor Control Act 1987*.

3. In regulation 1 "licensed premises" and "liquor" have the same meanings as in the *Liquor Control Act 1987*—(Rs 3321).

Every person who contravenes or fails to comply with these Regulations shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in section 13 of the *Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978*.
