Notice of Regulatory Impact Statement

It is proposed that new Regulations be made to replace the State Electricity Commission (Licensing of Electrical Mechanics) Regulations 1974.

The objectives of the Regulations are to:

- (a) ensure worker safety;
- (b) ensure installation safety;
- (c) provide a means of control of electrical workers;
- (d) ensure minimum competence of electrical workers;
- (e) assist with national uniformity of electrical licensing requirements.

A Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared and this concludes that the proposed Regulations are the most viable means of achieving the objectives. The potential benefits to the community of adopting the proposed Regulations outweigh any disadvantages.
