COUNCIL AND DISSOLVING THE
LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY
PROCLAMATION

I, Richard E. McGarvie, Governor of Victoria, acting under sections 8 (1), 8 (2) and 8 (3) of the *Constitution Act* 1975 and all other powers vested in me, Prorogue the Legislative Council and Dissolve the Legislative Assembly forthwith.

I have today excepted advice that on 21 August 1992 Writs be issued according to law for a general election of Members to be returned to serve in the Legislative Assembly and for a periodical election of Members to be returned to serve in the Legislative Council.

Vegetation and Vine Diseases Regulations 1992

In accordance with the provisions of the *Subordinate Legislation Act* 1962 notice is given of the proposal to make regulations to be known as the Vegetation and Vine Diseases Regulations 1992.

A Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared as required by the Subordinate Legislation Act.

The objective of these Regulations is to prevent the introduction and spread of plant pests and diseases.

The Regulatory Impact Statement concludes that the proposed regulations are the best means of achieving the stated objective.
