No. 19/1992

Title

1. This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Scallop Fishing—Ocean Fishery) (Amendment) Notice No. 19/1992.

Commencement

2. This Notice comes into operation on the Sunday following gazettal of this notice.

Objective

3. The objective of this Notice is to amend *Fisheries (Scallop Fishing—Ocean Fishery) Notice No. 13/1992 by increasing the catch limits of crates and sacks.

Authorising Provision

4. This Notice is made under section 80 of the *Fisheries Act 1968*.

Amendment of Catch Limit in Fisheries Notice No. 13/1992

5. (1) In sub-clause 8 (a) of the Fisheries (Scallop Fishing—Ocean Fishery) Notice No. 13/1992 for the number "30" substitute "40".

(2) In sub-clause 8 (b) of the Fisheries (Scallop Fishing—Ocean Fishery) Notice No. 13/1992 for the number "84" substitute "112".

(3) In the Table in sub-clause 9 (1) of the Fisheries (Scallop Fishing—Ocean Fishery) Notice No. 13/1992 for "30" wherever occurring substitute "40".

(4) In the Table in sub-clause 9 (1) of the Fisheries (Scallop Fishing—Ocean Fishery)

Notice No. 13/1992 for "75" wherever occurring substitute "112".

3. The objectives of this Notice is to fix a close season for scallop fishing in a particular area in Port Phillip Bay in order to facilitate the monitoring of the effects of scallop harvesting on the scallop fishery.

Authorising Provision

4. This Notice is made under section 80 of the *Fisheries Act 1968*.

Definitions

5. "Act" means the *Fisheries Act 1968*.

Close Season for Particular Areas

6. (1) A person must not during the currency of this Fisheries Notice:

- (a) use a dredge for taking scallops from the waters of Port Phillip Bay in areas described in Schedule 1 to this Notice; or
- (b) have a scallop dredge on board any boat on the waters of Port Phillip Bay in the areas described in Schedule 1 to this Notice.
- (2) The provisions of paragraph (1) (b) do not apply to persons proceeding to waters outside the closed areas via the most direct route.
- Penalty*
7. Any person who contravenes any provision of this Notice is liable to a penalty of 20 penalty units.

- (b) have a scallop dredge on board any boat on the waters of Port Phillip Bay in the areas described in Schedule 1 to this Notice.

(2) The provisions of paragraph (1) (b) do not apply to persons proceeding to waters outside the closed areas via the most direct route.

Penalty

7. Any person who contravenes any provision of this Notice is liable to a penalty of 20 penalty units.

SCHEDULE 1

Areas in which a Close Season Applies

All the waters of Port Phillip Bay adjacent Carrum bounded by the following: a straight line commencing at a latitude 38 deg. 3.5 min. S and longitude 145 deg. 3.35 min. E then proceeding directly to latitude 38 deg. 5 min. S and longitude 145 deg. 3.9 min. E, and then proceeding to latitude 30 deg. 5.75 min. S and longitude 145 deg. 0.55 min. E and then proceeding to a latitude 38 deg. 4.2 min. S and longitude 145 deg. E and then returning to the point of commencement.

This Notice replaces the Notice appearing in Gazette S.52 dated Friday, 2 October 1992.
