Planning and Environment Act 1987 MELTON PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Amendment Amendment L23

The Shire of Melton has prepared this amendment to the Local Section of the Melton Planning Scheme.

The amendment affects 269.62 hectares of land at Lots 1 and 2 of LP205674S; Crown Allotment 17, Section B and Part Crown Allotment 18, Section B (being proposed Lot 1 of PS320102N), Parish of Maribyrnong, being generally north of Taylors Road and west of the Shire of Melton boundary within the Melton East Growth Area.

The amendment proposes to rezone most of the land from Corridor "B" zone to a Reserved Living Zone. Lot 1 of LP205674S, containing an existing private Junior Secondary College (Gilson College), is proposed to be rezoned to a Special Use No. 1 Zone to reflect the existing use of the land.

Forests Act 1958 DECLARATION OF LAND NOT TO BE FIRE PROTECTED AREA

I, Charles Geoffrey Coleman, Minister for Natural Resources, after consultation with the Acting Secretary, and under section 3 (4) of the *Forests Act 1958*, declare that any land which is within 1.5 kilometres of any reserved forest or of any area of unoccupied Crown land proclaimed as a protected forest under this Act or any corresponding previous enactment or of any National Park or of any protected public land, which is situated within the parishes and parishes in the Schedule below, is not a fire protected area.

SCHEDULE

Billian—that portion comprising Section D, Allotments 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 6A, 6B, 6C.

Flowerdale—that portion comprising Section C, Allotments 15, 16, 17, 17A, 18, 18A, 18B, 18C, 19, 20, 20A, 20B, 20C, 21, 21A.

Linton—that portion adjacent to the Mount Disappointment Forest and Wallaby Creek Catchment.

Parliamentary Committees Act 1968
REFERRAL OF MATTERS TO THE
ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL
RESOURCES COMMITTEE

The Governor in Council under section 4F of the *Parliamentary Committees Act 1968* refers the following matters to the Environment and Natural Resources Committee:

To inquire into and report and make recommendations on:

- (a) the control within Victoria of the environmental impact of Commonwealth activities and places, and the application of State planning and environment law;
- (b) potential environmental issues associated with Commonwealth activities and places, including those controlled by agencies such as Telecom, Australia Post, Department of Defence, Federal Airports Corporation and Department of Administrative Services;
- (c) the Commonwealth's environmental responsibilities for land which it disposes of and therefore becomes subject to State Law; and
- (d) use of the Inter Governmental Agreement on the Environment to consider legislative clarifications, negotiation mechanisms and guidelines to ensure efficient and effective resolution of this issue.
