

Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1988

GENERAL MASS AND DIMENSION PERMIT AGRICULTURAL MACHINES AND AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS, AUTHORISED MULTIPLE ARTICULATIONS, RIGID VEHICLE TOWING AN AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENT, VEHICLE AND TRAILER COMBINATIONS

Regulation 724 of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1988 authorises the Roads Corporation, by notice in the Government Gazette, to allow vehicles which exceed mass or dimension limits prescribed in the Regulations to be used on highways.

Regulation 819 of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 1988 empowers the Roads Corporation to approve the use of a motor vehicle towing more than one other vehicle on a highway.

In accordance with that Regulation, I, Tony Fry, delegate of the Roads Corporation, hereby substitute for the second paragraph of Part 3 of the Victoria Gazette Notice No. S 28 Wednesday 13 June 1990 which begins with the words "Travel is also....." and ends with the words ".....3 January.", the following paragraph:

"Travel is also prohibited at all times when visibility is restricted to less than 500 metres by atmospheric conditions such as fog, hail etc. Travel between 29 December 1992 and 3 January 1993 is also prohibited on the: Hume Highway and Freeway, Western Highway and Freeway and Calder Highway and Freeway between Bendigo and Airport West."

This notice is effective until 31 December 1993.
