Shop Trading Act 1987
**EXEMPTION FROM CLOSING HOURS
PROVISIONS**
Festivals

Under section 8 (3) of the *Shop Trading Act* 1987, the Governor in Council exempts shops located in the Shire of Healesville from any part of the closing provisions of section 7 on the following days:

CITY OF MELBOURNE
Queen Victoria Market Local Law 1993
(No. 3 of 1993)

Notice is given that at a meeting of the Council of the City of Melbourne held on 9 March 1993, the Council made a Local Law titled "Queen Victoria Market Local Law 1993" (No. 3 of 1993) pursuant to the provisions of the *Local Government Act* 1989 ("the Act").

The purposes and general purport of the proposed Local Law are to—

- (a) provide for the regulation and government of the Market;
- (b) regulate the activities of persons in the market;
- (c) regulate the sale of goods and services in the Market;
- (d) promote the viability of, and retail competition in, the Market for the benefit of the members of the public, stallholders and lessees in the Market, and the Council; and

- (e) encourage a favourable environment for small business persons in the Market.

The Local Law substantially remakes the previous By-law and incorporates Market rules which have been in place since 1983, which were entitled "Conditions Affecting Stallholders Open Standings". The Local Law enables a new trader payments system, the licensing of traders, the issuing of infringement notices and seizure of goods. It also establishes a Queen Victoria Market Advisory Committee.

The Local Law incorporates Rules governing the Market, these Rules having been made concurrently with the Local Law. The Rules govern conduct of persons within the Market, including stallholders, stallholders' employees, members of the public, box hire operators and table and trestle hire operators.

In resolving to make the Local Law the Council took into consideration all relevant considerations including—

- (i) all submissions made under section 223 of the Act;
- (ii) the report of the Queen Victoria Market Local Law (Submissions) Committee ("the Committee") dated 3 March 1993; and
- (iii) the transcript of the hearings by the Committee of all the persons who were heard with respect to their submissions.

All persons who made written submissions will be notified in writing of the Council's decision and its reasons for doing so, in accordance with section 223 of the Act.

A copy of the proposed Local Law may be inspected at or purchased from the Office of the Town Clerk, 3rd Floor, Town Hall, Swanston Street, Melbourne, during office hours (i.e. 8.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. daily from Monday to Friday).
