## ACTS OF PARLIAMENT PROCLAMATION

I, Richard E. McGarvie, Governor of Victoria declare that I have today assented in Her Majesty's name to the following Bills.

No. 16/1993 (1) This Act (other than section 24) comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

(2) Section 24 comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.

No. 17/1993 (1) Subject to section 2, this Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

(2) Section 12 is deemed to have come into operation on 24 November 1992.

(3) Section 13 (2) is deemed to have come into operation on 7 June 1988.

No. 18/1993 (1) Section 1 and this section come into operation on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

(2) Subject to sub-section (3), the remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.

(3) If a provision referred to in sub-section (2) does not come into operation within the period of 6 months beginning on, and including, the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent, it comes into operation on the first day after the end of that period.

PROVISION OF MUNICIPAL SERVICES

The Governor in Council, acting under sections 25 and 26 of the *City of Greater Geelong Act 1993*, orders as follows:

1. On and from the appointed day, and for a period not exceeding thirty days thereafter, or such lesser period as may be agreed, the Council of the Shire of Bannockburn shall continue to supply municipal services to the area generally referred to as "the Fyansford area", formerly within the municipal district of the Shire of Bannockburn and now within the municipal district of the City of Greater Geelong.
2. On and from the appointed day, and for a period not exceeding thirty days thereafter, or such lesser period as may be agreed, the Barrabool Shire Council shall continue to supply municipal services to the area generally referred to as "the Wandana Heights and Jan Juc areas", formerly within the

municipal district of the Barrabool Shire Council and now within the municipal district of the City of Greater Geelong.

*City of Greater Geelong Act 1993*  
RESUBDIVISION OF THE MUNICIPAL  
DISTRICT OF THE SHIRE OF  
BANNOCKBURN

The Governor in Council, acting under sections 18 (1) and 25 of the *City of Greater Geelong Act 1993*, orders and directs as follows:

1. The municipal district of the Shire of Bannockburn shall, for the purposes of the next annual election after this Order takes effect and for ensuring elections, be subdivided into four ridings.
2. On and from 7 August 1993 being the day of the next annual election, the number of councillors in and for the Shire of Bannockburn as a result of the resubdivision shall be twelve.
3. The Councillors of the Shire of Bannockburn who are in office immediately before 7 August 1993 shall not all go out of office to the intent that the only councillors going out of office on that day shall be those councillors going out of office by rotation in accordance with section 32 (2) of the *Local Government Act 1989*.
4. The names and boundaries of the ridings shall be:

BARWON RIDING

Reduced and Redefined

Previous Gazettal 1988, 9/10 (Special No. 41)

Commencing on the western boundary of the Shire where it is intersected by the Shelford-Bannockburn Road; thence south-easterly by that road to Masons Road; thence southerly by that road and Spring Creek Road to the Gheringhap-Maroon Railway; thence easterly and north-easterly by that railway to the western boundary of allotment 3, Section 21, Parish of

Gheringhap; thence southerly by that boundary and the western boundary of allotment 2 and further southerly by the western boundary of allotment 3, Section 13 to the road forming the southern boundary of that allotment; thence easterly by that road to Dog Rocks Road, at the south-eastern angle of allotment 1, Section 16, being a point on the eastern boundary of the Shire, and thence generally southerly, westerly and north-easterly by the shire boundary to the point of commencement.

MOORABOOL RIDING

Reduced and Redefined

Previous Gazettal 1988, 9/10 (Special No. 41)

Commencing on the eastern boundary of the Shire of Pringles Bridge Road; thence westerly and north-westerly by that road and westerly by Thompsons Road to Steiglitz Road; thence southerly by that road to Perdrisat Road; thence north-westerly by that road to the Moorabool River; thence generally north-easterly and north-westerly by that river to the northern boundary of the Parish of Wabdallah; thence westerly by that boundary to the western boundary of the Shire; thence southerly by the shire boundary to the Shelford-Bannockburn Road; thence southerly by that road to Stephens Road; thence northerly by that road, north-easterly by Riddles Road, easterly by Scanlons Road and south-easterly by the Midlands Highway to the Fyansford-Gheringhap Road; thence south-easterly by that road to the road forming the northern boundary of allotment 7, Section 16, Parish of Gheringhap; thence easterly by that road to Dog Rocks Road, being a point on the eastern boundary of the Shire, and thence generally north-easterly and north-westerly by the shire boundary to the point of commencement.
