**Notice of Preparation of a Regulatory Impact
Statement**

A Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared in relation to the proposed Veterinary Surgeons (Fees) Regulations 1993.

The reason for, and the objective of, the proposed Regulations is to recover from Registered Veterinary Surgeons the costs associated with the regulation of veterinary science in Victoria.

The Regulatory Impact Statement concludes that, while there will be little financial impact on the veterinary profession from the increase in fees, the increase in fees is justified on the basis that they will enable the Veterinary Board of Victoria to continue to meet its statutory obligations in the active monitoring of the practice of veterinary medicine in Victoria which will be of continuing benefit to not only the profession itself, but to consumers who use the services of registered veterinarians.
