## ACTS OF PARLIAMENT PROCLAMATION

I, Richard E. McGarvie, Governor of Victoria declare that I have today assented in Her Majesty's name to the following Bills:

- No. 126/1993 Building Act 1993;
- No. 127/1993 Melbourne Wholesale Fruit and Vegetable Market Trust (Amendment) Act;
- No. 128/1993 Planning and Environment (Amendment) Act;
- No. 129/1993 Crimes (Amendment) Act;
- No. 130/1993 Electricity Industry Act.

No. 126/1993 (1) Sections 1 and 2 come into operation on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

(2) The remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.

(3) If a provision referred to in sub-section (2) does not come into operation before 1 March 1995, it comes into operation on that date.

No. 127/1993 (1) Part 1 comes into operation on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

(2) Subject to sub-section (3), the remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.

(3) If a provision referred to in sub-section (2) does not come into operation within the period of 6 months beginning on and including the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent, it comes into operation on the first day after the end of that period.

No. 128/1993 This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

No. 129/1993 (1) Part 1 comes into operation on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

(2) Subject to sub-section (3), Parts 2, 3 and 4 come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.

(3) If a provision referred to in sub-section (2) does not come into operation before 1 June 1994, it comes into operation on that date.

No. 130/1993 (1) Parts 1, 6 and 8, Division 1 of Part 5 and sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 13, 14, 15, 16, 20, 21, 22, 23, 30, 76, 86, 110, 111, 119 and 121 come into operation on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

(2) Subject to sub-section (3) the remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.

(3) If a provision referred to in sub-section (2) does not come into operation within the period of 12 months beginning on and including the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent, it comes into operation on the first day after the end of that period.
