Water Industry Act 1994 ORDER IN COUNCIL

The Governor in Council in the exercise of powers contained in section 110 (1) (a) of the Water Industry Act 1994 specifies that Melbourne Parks and Waterways may own, manage and control open space, parks and waterways for the purposes of conservation, recreation, leisure, tourism and navigation, within the areas defined either in Schedule 3 of the Melbourne and Metropolitan Board of Works Act 1958 No. 6310 or in the following table, being those areas:

- (a) in the case of items 1 to 14, defined in the Government Gazette identified in column 3 at the page identified (where applicable) in column 4, and as further defined (where applicable) in the drawings identified in column 5 and published in Melbourne Water Statutory Boundaries, (2nd Ed, Melbourne Water, 7 July 1993);
- (b) in the case of items 15 to 17, defined as indicated in column 3, and as described in the drawings published in Melbourne Water Statutory Boundaries.

Water Industry Act 1994 ORDER IN COUNCIL

From date of publication of this notice any police officer may enforce these provisions.
