#### Planning and Environment Act 1987 SUNSHINE PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment L34

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment L34 to the Sunshine Planning Scheme.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The amendment rezones about 27 hectares of land bounded by Rosamond Road and Warrs Road, Maribyrnong occupied by the Highpoint City Shopping Centre, from Restricted Business to a Highpoint City Regional Retail Centre Zone. The new zone will facilitate the expansion of the centre from 84500 square metres of gross leasable floor area to 124000 square metres of gross leasable floor area.

#### Fisheries Act 1968 FISHERIES NOTICE No. 9/1994

FISHERIES (KING CRAB FISHERY) NOTICE No. 9/1994

#### Title

1. This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries (King Crab Fishery) Notice No. 9/1994.

#### Commencement

2. This Notice commences on 21 April 1994.

#### Objective

3. The objective of this Notice is to control the taking of king crabs from Victorian waters as a consequence of Commonwealth and State management arrangements.

#### Authorising provisions

4. This Notice is made under sections 9 and 80 of the Fisheries Act 1968.

#### Close season

5. (1) A person must not during the period commencing on 21 April 1994 and ending on 20 July 1994—

- (a) land; or
- (b) retain on board any vessel; or
- (c) be in possession of; or
- (d) land--

any berried female king crabs (Pseudocarcinus gigas) in or adjacent to any Victorian waters.

- (2) A person must not during the period commencing on 21 April 1994 and ending on 20 July 1994—
  - (a) take; or
  - (b) retain on board any vessel; or
  - (c) be in possession of—

any dismembered king crabs (Pseudocarcinus gigas) in or adjacent to any Victorian waters.

#### Minimum size for taking of king crabs

- 6. (1) For the purposes of the Fisheries Act 1968, the minimum length with respect to the taking of king crabs (*Pseudocarcinus gigas*) is 150 millimetres.
- (2) In measuring king crabs (Pseudocarcinus gigas) for the purposes of sub-clause (1), the length must be measured in a straight line from the point on the carapace which is midway between the two central horns (between the eyes) to the opposite point at the rear of the carapace, but not including the ligament or any part of the belly flap.

#### Penalty

7. A person who contravenes any part of this Notice is liable to a penalty of 20 penalty units.

FISHERIES (USE OF FLOATING FISH TRAPS) PROHIBITION NOTICE 1994

#### Title

1. This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Use of Floating Fish Traps) Prohibition Notice No. 10/1994.

#### Commencement

2. This Notice commences on 20 April 1994.

#### Objective

3. The objective of this Notice is to prohibit the commercial targetting of Yellowtail Kingfish (Seriola Ialandi) by the use of floating fish traps in Victorian waters for the period commencing on 20 April 1994 and ending on 19 July 1994, except when a permit has been issued pursuant to section 45 of the Fisheries Act 1968.

#### Authorising provision

4. This Notice is made under section 80 of the Fisheries Act 1968.

Prohibition on the Use of Floating Fish Traps

5. A person who holds a licence issued pursuant to Part 3 of the Fisheries Act 1968 must not use a floating fish trap to take Yellowtail Kingfish (Seriola Ialandi) from Victorian waters for the period commencing on 20 April 1994 and ending on 19 July 1994.

#### Penalty

6. Any person who contravenes this Notice is liable to a penalty of 20 penalty units.
