WATER ACT 1989

I, Charles Geoffrey Coleman, as Minister administering the **Water Act 1989**, make the following Order:

APPOINTMENT OF THE CENTRAL HIGHLANDS REGION WATER AUTHORITY ORDER 1994

1. This Order is called the Appointment of the Central Highlands Region Water Authority Order 1994.

2. This Order is made under the powers conferred by Division 2 of Part 6 of the **Water Act 1989** and all other available powers.

3. This Order takes effect on the day on which it is published in the Government Gazette.

4. In this Order—

“Act” means the **Water Act 1989**.

5. On and from the date on which this Order takes effect the Central Highlands Region Water Authority takes over the whole of the property, rights, liabilities, obligations, powers and functions under the Act of the Moorabool Shire Council which were the property, rights, liabilities, obligations, powers and functions under the Act of the former Shire of Ballan

prior to its abolition on 6 May 1994 including the management and control of the existing water districts named below:

Ballan Urban
Ballan Waterworks
Blackwood Urban
Gordon—Mt. Egerton Rural
Gordon—Mt. Egerton Urban

and the management and control of the existing sewerage district named below:

Ballan Sewerage.

6. The Moorabool Shire Council is abolished as an Authority under the Act.

7. (a) This is an order referred to in section 98 (2) (a) of the Act.

(b) Under section 100 (2) (a) of the Act the affected Authorities have applied to me for this Order to be made.

(c) Under section 98 (2) (a) of the Act I have agreed to the terms and conditions for the take over made by this Order with the affected Authorities.
