#### Water Act 1989

I, Charles Geoffrey Coleman, as Minister administering the Water Act 1989, make the following Order:

## CONSTITUTION OF THE HOPKINS REGION WATER AUTHORITY ORDER 1994

#### Citation

1. This Order is called the Constitution of the Hopkins Region Water Authority Order 1994.

#### **Enabling Powers**

2. This Order is made under the powers conferred by Division 2 of Part 6 of the Water Act 1989 and all other available powers.

# Date of Effect

3. This Order takes effect on 1 July 1994.

# Definitions

- 4. In this Order
- "Act" means the Water Act 1989;

# "Former Authorities" mean:

- (a) The City of Warrnambool constituted by an Order in Council dated 27 September 1983 and published in the Government Gazette dated 28 September 1983;
- (b) the Mortlake Water Board constituted by an Order in Council dated 15 May 1984 and published in the Government Gazette dated 23 May 1984;
- (c) the Shire of Hampden constituted by an Order in Council dated 18 September 1984 and published in the Government Gazette dated 19 September 1984;
- (d) the Shire of Heytesbury constituted by an Order in Council dated 20 September 1983 and published in the Government Gazette dated 21 September 1983;
- (e) the Shire of Warrnambool constituted by an Order in Council dated 27 September 1983 and published in the

- Government Gazette dated 28 September 1983; and
- (f) the Town of Camperdown constituted by an Order in Council dated 27 September 1983 and published in the Government Gazette dated 28 September 1983;

"Corporation" means the Rural Water Corporation of Victoria;

"Otway Water Supply System" means the Otway Rural, Otway Urban and Otway Waterworks Districts of the Corporation.

#### Constitution of Hopkins Region Water Authority

- 5. On and from the date on which this Order takes effect:
  - (a) there is constituted a new Authority;
  - (b) the corporate name of the new Authority is the Hopkins Region Water Authority.

#### Takeover of Former Authorities

- 6. On and from the date on which this Order takes effect the new Authority constituted by Clause 5 of this Order takes over:
  - (a) the whole of the property, rights, liabilities, obligations, powers and functions under the Act of the Former Authorities including the management and control of the existing water districts named below:

City of Warrnambool Water Supply;

Mortlake Urban;

Mortlake Waterworks;

Derrinallum Urban;

Lismore and Derrinallum Waterworks;

Lismore Rural;

Lismore Urban;

Port Campbell Urban; Shire of Heytesbury Waterworks;

Timboon Urban;

Caramut Rural:

Caramut Water Supply;

Koroit Urban;

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Koroit Waterworks; Peterborough Urban; Peterborough Waterworks; Purnim Urban; and Town of Camperdown Water Supply; and the management and control of the existing sewerage districts named below:

Warrnambool Sewerage; Terang Sewerage; Cobden Sewerage; Port Campbell Sewerage; Simpson Sewerage; and Camperdown Sewerage.

# Takeover of the Otway Water Supply System of the Corporation

- 7. On and from the date on which this Order takes effect:
  - (a) the Hopkins Region Water Authority takes over all the rights, liabilities, obligations, powers and functions in respect of the Otway Rural, Otway Urban and Otway Waterworks districts of the Corporation under the Water Act 1989 in addition to the works, property and other assets owned by or vested in the Corporation which are associated with these districts and are listed below:

# (ii) Other Assets

- 1. All works situated in the Otway Rural, Otway Urban and Otway Waterworks districts of the Corporation which are ancillary to, incidental to, connected to or necessary for the operation of the works listed above; and
- 2. All reticulation, meters and other minor works situated in the above districts of the Corporation; and
- 3. All records and files related to the above districts of the Corporation which are necessary for the operation of the assets listed above; and

## (iii) Property

The following property owned by or vested in the Corporation is transferred to and taken over by the Hopkins Region Water Authority:

 All land situated in the Otway Rural, Otway Urban and Otway Waterworks districts of the Corporation, including all buildings situated on such land, and all rights and interests in leases and licences in respect of land and buildings situated in these districts of the Corporation granted to or by the Corporation; and All easements and reserves in respect of land situated in these districts of the Corporation;

With the exception of land and buildings situated at:

6 McNicol Street, Camperdown;

29 Ferguson Street, Camperdown;

71 Swanston Street, Terang; 38 Silvestor Street, Cobden;

Pt Crown Allotment 82B2 Parish of Purrumbete South CT Vol 7043 Folio 405.

#### Membership of the Hopkins Region Water Authority

8. (a) The membership of the new Authority constituted in Clause 5 of this Order is nine members appointed by the Minister in writing of whom—

> One member shall be nominated by the Council of the City of Warrnambool;

> One member shall be nominated by the Council of the Shire of Warrnambool;

> One member shall be nominated by the Council of the Shire of Hampden;

> One member shall be nominated by the Council of the Shire of Heytesbury;

> One member shall be nominated by the Council of the Town of Camperdown; and

> One member shall be nominated by the Council of the Shire of Mortlake.

- (b) In appointing persons as members, the Minister must ensure that the members, collectively, have qualifications relevant to, or experience in each of the following:
  - (i) the business of the new Authority;
  - (ii) public finance or economics;
  - (iii) engineering;
  - (iv) business management;
  - (v) commerce;
  - (vi) banking;
  - (vii) environmental and water resource management;

(viii) law.

Abolition of the Former Authorities

9. The Former Authorities are abolished.

# Pre-requisites for Making this Order

- 10. (a) This is an order referred to in Section 98 (2) (a) of that Act;
  - (b) Under Section 100 (2) (a) of the Act the affected Authorities, the City of Warrnambool, the Mortlake Water Board, the Shire of Hampden, the Shire of Heytesbury, the Shire of Warrnambool, the Town of Camperdown and the Corporation have applied to me for this Order to be made; and
  - (c) Under Section 98 (2) (a) of the Act I have agreed to the terms and conditions for the take over made by this Order with the affected Authorities and the Corporation.
  - (d) Under Section 100 (2) (b) of the Act I have consulted with the Minister administering the Local Government Act 1989 as a council is affected.

#### CONSTITUTION OF THE GLENELG REGION WATER AUTHORITY ORDER 1994

#### Citation

1. This Order is called the Constitution of the Glenelg Region Water Authority Order 1994.

# **Enabling Powers**

2. This Order is made under the powers conferred by Division 2 of Part 6 of the Water Act 1989 and all other available powers.

# Date of Effect

3. This Order takes effect on 1 July 1994.

# Definitions

4. In this Order

"Act" means the Water Act 1989;

"Former Authorities" mean:

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- (a) The Hamilton Water Board constituted by an Order in Council dated 20 September 1983 and published in the Government Gazette dated 21 September 1983;
- (b) the Glenelg-Wannon Water Board constituted by an Order in Council dated 18 December 1984 and published in the Government Gazette dated 19 December 1984; and
- (c) the Shire of Mt Rouse constituted by an Order in Council dated 15 November 1983 and published in the Government Gazette dated 23 November 1983.

# Constitution of Glenelg Region Water Authority

- 5. On and from the date on which this Order takes effect:
  - (a) there is constituted a new Authority;
  - (b) the corporate name of the new Authority is the Glenelg Region Water Authority.

## Takeover of Former Authorities

- 6. On and from the date on which this Order takes effect the new Authority constituted by Clause 5 of this Order takes over:
  - (a) the whole of the property, rights, liabilities, obligations, powers and functions under the Act of the Former Authorities including the management and control of the existing water districts named below:

Hamilton Urban; Hamilton Waterworks: Macarthur Water District; Cavendish Urban; Shire of Dundas Waterworks: Tarrington Urban; Balmoral Waterworks; Casterton Urban; Coleraine Urban; Coleraine and Casterton Waterworks: Merino Urban; Sandford Urban; Shire of Glenelg Waterworks; Dunkeld Urban; Glenthompson Urban; Penshurst Urban; Shire of Mt Rouse Waterworks;

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and the management and control of the existing sewerage districts named below:

Hamilton Sewerage; Casterton Sewerage;

Coleraine Sewerage; and

(b) the staff of the Hamilton Water Board and the Glenelg-Wannon Water Board.

# Membership of Glenelg Region Water Authority

- 7.(a) The membership of the new Authority constituted in Clause 5 of this Order is seven members appointed by the Minister in writing.
- (b) In appointing persons as members, the Minister must ensure that the members, collectively, have qualifications relevant to, or experience in each of the following:
  - (i) the business of the new Authority;
  - (ii) public finance or economics;
  - (iii) engineering;
  - (iv) business management;
  - (v) commerce;
  - (vi) banking;
  - (vii) environmental and water resource management;
  - (viii) law.

# Abolition of Former Authorities

- 8. The Former Authorities are abolished.
- 9.(a) This is an Order referred to in Section 98 (2) (a) of the Act;
- (b) Under Section 100 (2) (a) of the Act the affected Authorities, the Hamilton Water Board, the Glenelg-Wannon Water Board and the Shire of Mt Rouse have applied to me for this Order to be made: and
- (c) Under Section 98 (2) (a) of the Act I have agreed to the terms and conditions for the take over made by this Order with the affected Authorities.
- (d) Under Section 100 (2) (b) of the Act I have consulted with the Minister administering the Local Government Act 1989 as a council is affected.

- 1. This Order is called the Appointment of the Central Highlands Region Water Authority Order 1994 No. 2.
- 2. This Order is made under the powers conferred by Division 2 of Part 6 of the Water Act 1989 and all other available powers.
  - 3. This Order takes effect from 1 July 1994.
- 4. In this Order:
  - "Act" means the Water Act 1989.
- "Former Authority" means the Learmonth Water Board constituted by an Order in Council dated 5 June 1984.
- 5. On and from the date on which this Order takes effect the Central Highlands Region Water Authority is appointed to take over the whole of the property, rights, liabilities, obligations,

powers and functions under the Act of the Former Authority including the management and control of the existing water district named below:

## Learmonth Waterworks District

- 6. The Former Authority is abolished.
- 7.(a) This is an Order referred to in section 98 (2) (a) of the Act.
  - (b) Under section 100 (2) (a) of the Act, the affected Authorities, Central Highlands Region Water Authority and Learmonth Water Board, have applied to me for the Order to be made.
  - (c) Under section 98 (2) of the Act I have agreed the terms and conditions for the takeover made by this Order with the affected Authorities.
