1. This Order is called the Appointment of the Goulburn Valley Region Water Authority Order 1994 No. 4.

2. This Order is made under the powers conferred by Division 2 of Part 6 of the Water Act 1989 and all other available powers.

3. This Order takes effect on and from 1 October 1994.

4. In this Order:

“Act” means the Water Act 1989.

“Former Authority” means the Waranga Water Board constituted by an Order in Council dated 20 December 1983 and published in the Government Gazette 21 December 1983.

On and from the date on which this Order takes effect the Goulburn Valley Region Water Authority takes over the whole of the property, rights, liabilities, obligations, powers and functions under the Act of the Former Authority including the management and control of the existing water districts named below:
