2. Rule 2 (2) was repealed and in lieu thereof the following rule was made:

"On and after the rising of the House at the conclusion of the 1993 General Assembly the members of the Corporation shall be the persons holding the offices of first, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth and tenth elected member respectively of the Board of Investment and Finance of the General Assembly for the time being."

3. Rule 3 was repealed and in lieu thereof the following rule was made:

"The fact that the membership of the Corporation has for any reason fallen below ten shall not invalidate any action proceeding or resolution of the Corporation so long as a quorum was present at any meeting at which such action or proceeding took place or resolution was adopted."

MORTLAKE WATER BOARD

Notice of Creation of Proposed Mortlake Sewerage District and Area of Interest

Notice is hereby given that, under the provisions of section 96 (7) of the **Water Act 1989**, the Mortlake Water Board intends making a proposal to the Minister for Natural Resources to set up a new sewerage district and an Area of Interest at Mortlake. The new sewerage district is to be known as the "Mortlake Sewerage District" covering the Mortlake township and the Industrial Estate (but excluding the saleyards), while the "Area of Interest" is located to the west of Mortlake on Connewarren Lane adjacent to the Shire Rubbish Tip.

The Sewerage District is being proposed in ultimate anticipation of the construction of a sewerage scheme in Mortlake.
