Part 1—Specified Vehicles and Load

1.1 This General Permit only applies to six axle articulated vehicles that have a current "C" Increased Mass Limits Permit, that consists of a prime mover with a tandem axle group at the rear having 8 tyres and a semi-trailer with a tri-axle group having 12 tyres as defined below, transporting shipping containers and subject to the conditions specified in Parts 2, 3 and 4.

1.2 Definitions

In this schedule—

"articulated vehicle" means a vehicle consisting of a prime mover and a semi-trailer;

"prime mover" means a motor vehicle which is constructed, designed or adapted for connection to a semi-trailer;

"semi-trailer" means a vehicle without its own motive power which is capable of being drawn by a prime mover in such a way that it is attached to and pivoted on the prime mover by imposition on it on or in front of the rear axle of the prime mover so that the semi-trailer is free to turn relative to the prime mover when the prime mover is rounding a curve and so that part of the mass of the semi-trailer and of any load carried on it is borne by the prime mover;

"single axle" means—

- (a) one axle; or
- (b) two axles less than one metre apart;

"tandem axle group" means two consecutive axles—

- (a) the centres of which are not less than one metre and not more than two metres apart; and
- (b) which relate to each other through a load sharing suspension system;

"tri-axle group" means three consecutive axles—

- (a) the centres of the outermost of which are not less than two metres nor more than 3.2 metres apart; and
- (b) which relate to each other through a load sharing suspension system;

"gross vehicle mass (GVM)" means maximum laden mass of a motor vehicle as specified by its manufacturer;

“gross trailer mass (GTM)” means the mass transmitted to the ground by the axle or axles of the trailer when it is uniformly loaded to the maximum load recommended by the manufacturer;

“gross combination mass (GCM)” means the mass specified by the vehicle manufacturer as being the maximum of the sum of the GVM of the vehicle plus the GTM of any trailer which may be towed;

“container” means a container designed to hold freight, that has at least a twist lock in each corner of its base and its base is either 6.1 metres long or 12.2 metres long.

Part 2—Permitted Mass Limits

2.1 Scope

This permit applies only to the mass limits for 6 axle articulated vehicles carrying containers.

2.2 Mass Limits

2.2.1 The maximum axle mass limits are the lesser of:

- (a) steering single axle—6.0 tonnes gross tandem axle group—18.0 tonnes gross tri-axle group—24.0 tonnes gross;
- (b) the manufacturers’ mass ratings; or
- (c) the sum of the mass limits for the tyres fitted to the axle or axle group.

2.2.2 The maximum gross mass limits are the lesser of:

- (a) 48.0 tonnes gross;
- (b) the sum of the axle and axle group mass limits from 2.2.1 above;
- (c) the sum of the manufacturer’s mass limits for the prime mover (GVM) and the trailer (GTM); or
- (d) the gross combination mass (GCM) limit specified by the prime mover manufacturer.

Benalla Water Management Scheme

I, Charles Geoffrey Coleman, the Minister for Natural Resources, have agreed that an investigation in relation to water management be carried out for the City of Benalla, and that a community based committee be appointed under section 214 of the Water Act 1989.

In October 1993 a major flood occurred on the Broken River causing extensive flooding in the City of Benalla. The flood was the largest experienced this century in Benalla, and resulted in heavy damage to private and public property and considerable community hardship. The severity of the 1993 flood led to the City of Benalla calling for a flood plan for future floods and the future development of Benalla and its environs. With funds made available by the Government of Victoria, the City of Benalla has now appointed engineering consultants Willing and Partners to carry out a study.

The study area covers the City of Benalla area and its immediate outskirts within the Shire of Benalla.

The study tasks to be undertaken by the consultants will include the determination of flood flows and flood levels for a range of flood events; an assessment of the 1993 flood; a review of previous flood studies; recommendations for a flood mitigation scheme which may include both structural works and non-structural measures, such as flood warning and flood action plans.

A community based committee will co-ordinate the flood study and provide a forum for ongoing public consultation throughout the study. The committee will be made up of representative landowners in the study area,

public statutory bodies and other relevant interests (including environmental). Representation on the committee is being determined in consultation between the City of Benalla and the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.

When the flood investigation has been completed, the committee will prepare a water management scheme for public exhibition and comment under section 215 of the Water Act 1989.
