Notice of Approval of Amendment
Amendment S51

The Minister for Planning has prepared and approved the above amendment.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The amendment inserts a provision in the State Section of all schemes which requires a responsible authority to include a condition in a permit for an outdoor advertising sign which, in effect, limits the validity of the permit to a period not exceeding four years from the date of issue of the permit.

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment L93 to the Springvale Planning Scheme.

The amendment allows the use and development of land located on the eastern side of the Mornington Peninsula Freeway, Bangholme, on the northern side of the Patterson River adjoining the National Water Sports Centre for a sky sign subject to a number of conditions.
