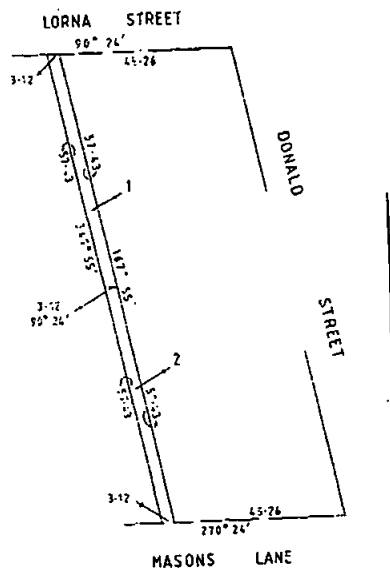

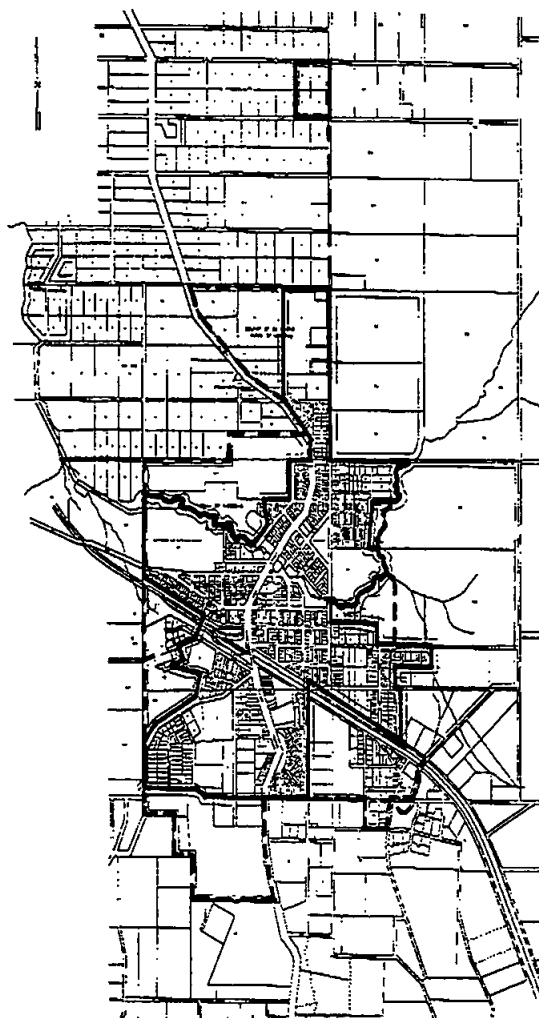

(a) Ms Visser undertake and complete a course or courses of further education, approved by the Nurses Board of Victoria, on professional ethics, including client/patient's rights, career counselling; and client focused care; and produce to the Nurses Board of Victoria evidence of satisfactory completion of that further education.

3. After the suspension pursuant to paragraph 1 of this determination is ended, Ms Visser may practice as a nurse only under the supervision of a person approved in writing by the Nurses Board of Victoria, pursuant to section 48 (2) (e) Nurses Act 1993, until that restriction is removed pursuant to paragraph 5 of this determination.
4. Pursuant to paragraph 3 of this determination, Ms Visser must undertake not less than 6 months supervised clinical practice and produce to the Nurses Board of Victoria a report from the supervisor that is satisfactory to the Nurses Board of Victoria.
5. Upon receipt of a satisfactory report pursuant to paragraph 4 of this determination, the restriction imposed by paragraph 3 of this determination be revoked.
