Environment

- (a) to provide a safe and healthy environment in which the residents of the municipal district are able to enjoy a quality of life that meets the general expectations of the community;
- (b) to prohibit, regulate and control activities which may be dangerous, unsafe or detrimental to the quality of life in an environment of the municipal district;

- (c) to facilitate the provision of general public services, health and other community services, property services, recreational and cultural services, and other services in a way which enhances the environment and quality of life in the municipal district;
- (d) to control nuisances and noise, odour and smoke emissions, and other discharges to the environment which may adversely affect the enjoyment of life within the municipal district or the health, safety and welfare of persons within the municipal district.

Municipal Places

- (a) to allow and protect the appropriate enjoyment by people of municipal places within the municipal district;
- (b) to enable people in the municipal district to carry out their activities and to enjoy their recreational pursuits without having their peace and enjoyment interfered with or destroyed.

Streets and Roads

- (a) to provide and control for the management of traffic, use of roads by persons, vehicles and animals and to regulate the parking of vehicles for the safety and fair use by people in the municipal district.

- (a) to provide a method for obtaining permits under other provisions of the Local Law;
- (b) to provide for a fair and equitable structure of fees and charges for Council services;

1. This Order may be cited as the Zoological Parks and Gardens (Waiving of Admission Charges) Order 1995.

Objective

2. The objective of this Order is to provide for the waiving of admission charges to the Royal Melbourne Zoological Gardens and the Sir Colin MacKenzie Zoological Park, for certain members of the public at certain times.

Authorising provision

3. Section 14A of the **Zoological Parks and Gardens Act 1967**.

Revocation

4. The Order in Council made on 19 January 1993 and published in Government Gazette No. G17 on 28 April 1994, page 1052, is revoked.

Admission charges waived for certain members of the public

5. (1) On any day on which the Royal Melbourne Zoological Gardens and the Sir Colin MacKenzie Zoological Park are open to the public, admission charges are waived for the following persons—

- (a) child aged less than 4 years of age; and
- (b) person who is a carer of a physically or intellectually disabled person, when accompanying such a person; and
- (c) teachers and supervising parents accompanying children on official visits from educational institutions (on a ratio of 1 teacher or parent to 6 children).

(2) On any day on which the Royal Melbourne Zoological Gardens and the Sir Colin MacKenzie Zoological Park are open to the public, except on Sundays and public holidays, admission charges are waived for the following persons—

- (a) person who is socially, physically or intellectually disadvantaged on an official arranged group visit from an institution for such persons; and
- (b) person who is a carer or supervisor of a group specified in paragraph (a).

(3) On any day on which the Royal Melbourne Zoological Gardens or the Sir Colin MacKenzie Zoological Park are open during normal opening hours, admission charges to those Gardens or that Park are waived for any person who is a registered financial member of the society known as "Friends of the Zoos" on presentation of a current valid membership card.

(4) On any day on which the Royal Melbourne Zoological Gardens are open to the public after the normal closing hours for those Gardens, admission charges are waived for any person who is a registered financial member of the society known as "Friends of the Zoos" who is admitted to the Gardens before 4.00 p.m., on presentation of a current valid membership card.

RATING ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE PORT
PHILLIP CITY COUNCIL

The Governor in Council acting under subsection 220R (1) of Part 10C of the **Local Government Act 1989** orders that:

Definitions

1. In this Order—

“general rate” means a general rate under the **Local Government Act 1989**;

“rateable property” means a rateable property within the municipal district of the Port Phillip City Council.

Commencement

2. This Order comes into operation on the day it is published in the Government Gazette.

Transitional Arrangements

3. The general rate for each rateable property in respect of the 1995–1996 financial year shall be the lesser of the following amounts—

- (a) the general rate for that property in respect of the 1994–1995 financial year increased by a factor of 10 per cent; and
- (b) the general rate for that property had this Order not been made.

4. If in the 1995–1996 financial year a rateable property became rateable for the first time or a supplementary valuation was made under section 13DF of the **Valuation of Land Act 1960**, the general rate in respect of that year, adjusted in accordance with section 13DF (4) of that Act, shall be the lesser of the following amounts—

- (a) the amount determined by multiplying the net annual value of the land as at 30 June 1990 by the general rate in the dollar declared in respect of the 1994–1995 financial year, and which is increased by a factor of 10 per cent for the 1995–1996 financial year; and
- (b) the general rate for that property had this Order not been made.

5. If in the 1994–1995 financial year a rateable property became rateable for the first time or a supplementary valuation was made under section 13DF of the **Valuation of Land Act 1960**, then for the purposes of clause 3 (a) the general rate is the general rate as assessed for the full rating period.
