ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS ACT 1983

The Governor in Council makes the following Order:

ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS ORDER (NO 150) 1996

- 1. This Order is called the Administrative Arrangements Order (No 150) 1996.
- 2 This Order is made under the powers conferred by section 3 of the Administrative Arrangements Act 1983 and under every other available power.
- 3. This Order take effect on and from 3 April 1996.
- In respect of each item in the Schedule a reference to the Old Body in any provision of an Act, a statutory instrument specified in Column 2 or in any statutory or other instrument made under any provision of an Act specified in Column 2 or in respect of any contract, agreement or other matter made or done under any provision of an Act or statutory instrument specified in Column 2 shall be construed as a reference in the New Body.
- 5, Where -
 - (a) before this Order takes effect, a transaction happened in relation to an Old Body, then -
 - (b) this Order does not affect the validity or continuity of the transaction, and the transaction shall continue and may be completed in relation to the New Body in the same way as it would have been continued and may have been completed in relation to the Old Body if this Order has not been made.
- 6. In this Order -

"The Act" means the Administrative Arrangements Act 1983.

"Body" means Minister, Department or Officer.

"Instrument" includes contract and agreement.

"Old Body" and "New Body" mean respectively the Bodies specified in Column 1 and Column 3 of the item in Schedule.

"Schedule" means Schedule to this Order.

"Transaction" includes -

- (a) Agreement, bond, contract, deed or other consensual arrangement whatsoever;
- (b) Action, appeal, arbitration, prosecution and other legal proceeding whatsoever;
- (c) Assignment, charge, lease, mortgage, transfer or other dealing with property whatsoever,

- (d) Loan, guarantee, indemnity or other dealing with money whatsoever,
- (e) Approval, consent, delegation, direction, licence, order, permit, requirement or other authority whatsoever;
- (f) Notice; and
- (g) Any other act, entitlement or liability in the law whatsoever.
- 7. Where as a result of an administrative change which takes place consequent on the restructure of departments following an Order made on 3 April 1996 under sections 107 and 108 of the Public Sector Management Act 1992 amending Schedule 1 to that Act, an officer is transferred from one department to another under the provisions of section 77 or 81 of the Public Sector Management Act 1992, any reference to a department or to an officer within the meaning of section 2 of the Act in -
 - (a) any employment agreement entered into by the officer under the Employee Relations Act 1992;
 - (b) any contract of employment entered into by the officer under Part 4 of the Public Sector Management Act 1992; or
 - (c) in any other agreement, contract or arrangement affecting the employment of the officer

shall be construed as a reference to the department to which the officer has been so transferred and to the person holding the position specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 of the *Public Sector Management Act* in respect of that department respectively.

- 8. Without limiting the operation of clause 7 above, where an administrative change takes place consequent on the restructure of departments following an Order made on 3 April 1996 under sections 107 and 108 of the Public Sector Management Act 1992 amending Schedule 1 to that Act, any reference to a department or to an officer within the meaning of section 2 of the Act in any employment agreement made under the Employee Relations Act 1992, or in any contract, agreement or other arrangement whereby services are provided or supplied to a department or to the State of Victoria shall be construed as a reference to the department to which the function in respect of which the services are provided has been transferred and to the person holding the position specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 of the Public Sector Management Act 1992 in respect of that department respectively.
- 9. (a) The body corporate established by section 6 (1) of the Conservation, Forests and Lands Act 1987 and called "the Secretary to the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources" will hereafter be known as "the Secretary to the Department of Natural Resources and Environment".

- (b) Any reference in section 6 of the Conservation, Forests and Lands Act 1987 or in any other provision of that Act or in any statutory or other instrument made under any provision of an Act to the body corporate called "the Secretary to the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources" ("the Old Body") shall be construed as a reference to the body corporate known as "the Secretary to the Department of Natural Resources and Environment" ("the New Body").
- (a) The body corporate established by section 35 (1) of the Project Development and Construction Act 1995 and called "the Secretary to the Department of Planning and Development" will hereafter be known as "the Secretary to the Department of Infrastructure".
 - (b) Any reference in section 35 of the Project Development and Construction Act 1995 or in any other provision of that Act or in any statutory or other instrument made under any provision of an Act to the body corporate called "the Secretary to the Department of Planning and Development" ("the Old Body") shall be construed as a reference to the body corporate known as "the Secretary to the Department of Infrastructure" ("the New Body").
- (a) The body corporate established by section 6 (1) of the Health Act 1958 and called "the Secretary to the Department of Health and Community Services" will hereafter be known as "the Secretary to the Department of Human Services".
 - (b) Any reference in section 6 of the Health Act 1958 or in any other provision of that Act or in any statutory or other instrument made under any provision of an Act to the body corporate called "Secretary to the Department of Health and Community Services" ("the Old Body") shall be construed as a reference to the body corporate known as "the Secretary to the Department of Human Services" ("the New Body").
- Items 64 and 65 in the Schedule apply only to or in respect or activities carried out under the Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1967 of the Commonwealth or the Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1982 of Victoria.
