

  - (a) By Order dated 21 September 1993, the Minister for Energy and Minerals administers the Government's policies and the laws relating to occupational health and safety and dangerous goods with respect to activities carried out under the Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act 1970, Dangerous Goods Act 1985, Lifts and Cranes Act 1967, Liquefied Gases Act 1968, Occupational Health and Safety Act 1985 and the Scaffolding Act 1971 in so far as they relate to activities carried out under the Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1967 (Cth) and the Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1982 (Vic).
