Subordinate Legislation Act 1994 **CHATTEL SECURITIES REGULATIONS** 1997

A Regulatory Impact Statement for the proposed Chattel Securities Regulations 1997 was released for public comment on 17 July 1997. Submissions were received and have been considered. As a result of the submissions, the draft Regulations are to be amended to reduce the "purchase price amount" to \$30,000 rather than the \$40,000 initially proposed, and, to allow time for the changing of internal financial systems, the proposed fee changes will not occur until 1 January 1998. I advise that I intend to recommend that the draft Regulations, as amended, be made.

Planning and Environment Act 1987 **GREATER GEELONG PLANNING SCHEME** Notice of Lapsing of Amendment Amendment RL175

The Minister for Planning and Local Government has resolved to abandon Amendment RL175 to the Greater Geelong Planning Scheme.

The amendment proposed to develop Freeway Service Centres near the present Rest Areas on the Princes Freeway West close to Little River, referred to as Geelong Gateway. The amendment has been abandoned consistent with the recommendations of an independent Panel considering submissions to the amendment, in conjunction with an Advisory Committee established by the Minister for Planning and Local Government.

The amendment lapsed on 11 September 1997.

Planning and Environment Act 1987 **GREATER GEELONG PLANNING SCHEME** Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment RL112

The Minister for Planning and Local Government has approved Amendment RL112 to the Greater Geelong Planning Scheme.

The amendment introduces a site specific designation of two adjacent sites for Freeway Service Centres on the Princess Freeway near the present Little River Rest Areas and rezones a portion of the existing Rest Areas for Existing Freeway reservation to Rural General Farming zone.

Planning and Environment Act 1987 **WERRIBEE PLANNING SCHEME** Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment L100
