Planning and Environment Act 1987 VICTORIA PLANNING PROVISIONS Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment V3

The Minister for Planning and Local Government has approved Amendment V3 to the Victoria Planning Provisions.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The amendment substitutes a new, updated version of the Victoria Planning Provisions for the previously approved version. It is a comprehensive amendment to the Victoria Planning Provisions which includes:

Many of the recommendations of both the Advisory Committee into the Victoria Planning Provisions and other Advisory Committees relating to car parking,

advertising signs on major routes, development controls, retailing and cinemas.

- * Improvements arising from Councils' experiences in the development of new planning schemes.
- * Amendments to the State Section of planning schemes which have occurred since the Victoria Planning Provisions were introduced.

Planning and Environment Act 1987 DAREBIN PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment L42

The Minister for Planning and Local Government has approved Amendment L42 to the Darebin Planning Scheme.
