Fisheries Act 1968 FISHERIES (PROHIBITION ON TRAWLING AND THE TAKING OF FINFISH) NOTICE No. 6/1997

I, Patrick McNamara, Minister for Agriculture and Resources, after consultation with the Victorian Fishing Industry Federation, make the following Fisheries Notice:

Objective

1. The objective of this Notice is to prohibit trawling and the taking of finfish by non-trawl methods in waters that are more than 3 nautical miles from the coast of Victoria.

Authorising provision

2. This Notice is made under section 80 of the Fisheries Act 1968.

Commencement

3. This Notice comes into operation on 18 December 1997.

Definitions

4. In this Notice—

“**Finfish Fishery Arrangement**” means the ARRANGEMENT BETWEEN THE COMMONWEALTH AND THE STATE OF VICTORIA IN RELATION TO THE FISHERY FOR FINFISH TO BE MANAGED UNDER STATE LAW IN WATERS RELEVANT TO VICTORIA published in the Commonwealth of Australia Gazette on 31 October 1997;

“**non-trawl methods**” means any method of fishing other than trawling;

“**outside waters**” means that part of the waters to which the Trawl Fishery Arrangement applies (see clause 4 of this Arrangement) that are more than 3 nautical miles from the coast of Victoria;

“**Trawl Fishery Arrangement**” means the ARRANGEMENT BETWEEN THE COMMONWEALTH AND THE STATE OF VICTORIA IN RELATION TO THE TRAWL FISHERY TO BE MANAGED UNDER STATE LAW IN WATERS RELEVANT TO VICTORIA published in the Commonwealth of Australia Gazette on 31 October 1997;

“**trawling**” includes board trawling, midwater or pelagic trawling and Danish seining.

Prohibition on the taking of fish by trawling outside 3 miles

5. (1) In this clause “specified fish” means any of the fish listed in clause 2(a) or (b) of the Trawl Fishery Arrangement.
- (2) A person must not take any specified fish by trawling in outside waters during the period starting on the day this Notice is published and ending on the day this Notice is revoked.
- (3) Sub-clause (2) does not apply
- (a) to a person who was entitled on 31 October 1997 to take any specified fish by trawling in outside waters under a law of the Commonwealth;
- (b) to a person—
- (i) who is entitled to take any specified fish by trawling in outside waters under a licence or permit issued under the law of Victoria; and
- (ii) who obtained that entitlement either by being issued with a new licence or permit, or by having the entitlement added to an existing licence or permit, after 1 November 1997.

Prohibition on the taking of finfish by non-trawl methods outside 3 miles

6. (1) In this clause "finfish" means the fish listed in clauses 2(a) and (b) of the Finfish Fishery Arrangement.
- (2) A person must not take specified fish by trawling in outside waters during the period starting on the day this Notice is published and ending on the day this Notice is revoked.
- (3) Sub-clause (2) does not apply
- (a) to a person who was entitled on 31 October 1997 to take finfish by non-trawl methods in outside waters under a law of the Commonwealth;
- (b) to a person—
- (i) who is entitled to take finfish by non-trawl methods in outside waters under a licence or permit issued under the law of Victoria; and
- (ii) who obtained that entitlement either by being issued with a new licence or permit, or by having the entitlement added to an existing licence or permit, after 1 November 1997.
- (4) Sub-clause (2) does not apply to the taking of any finfish in the circumstances referred to in clause 2(a) of the Finfish Fishery Arrangement under the list of fish.

Penalty

7. Any person who contravenes any provisions of this Notice is liable to a penalty of 20 penalty units.

FISHERIES (SCALLOP-OCEAN FISHERY)
(CLOSE SEASON) NOTICE NO. 7/1997

Title

1. This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Scallop - Ocean Fishery) (Close Season) Notice No. 7/1997.

Commencement

2. This Notice commences on 21 December 1997.

Objective

3. The objective of this Notice is to fix a close season on the taking of scallops from Victorian waters, other than Port Phillip Bay.

Authorising provision

4. This Notice is made under section 80 of the **Fisheries Act 1968**.

Revocation

5. The Fisheries (Scallop - Ocean Fishery) Notice No. 5/1997 published in Government Gazette No. S.99 on 26 August 1997 is **revoked**.

Definitions

6. In this Notice—
- "**Act**" means the **Fisheries Act 1968**;
- "**crate**" has the same meaning as in the Fisheries (Scallop) Regulations 1995¹;
- "**crate tag**" has the same meaning as in the Fisheries (Scallop) Regulations 1995;
- "**sack**" has the same meaning as in the Fisheries (Scallop) Regulations 1995;
- "**sack tag**" has the same meaning as in the Fisheries (Scallop) Regulations 1995;

Close Season

7. A person must not—
- (a) use a dredge for taking scallops from Victorian waters other than Port Phillip Bay; or
- (b) have a scallop dredge on board a vessel on Victorian waters other than Port Phillip Bay—
- during the period commencing on 21 December 1997 and ending on 31 May 1998².

Returning unused scallop tags

8. The owner of a registered fishing boat for which an appropriately endorsed scallop licence has been issued under the Act must, no later

than 28 January 1998, return to the Secretary at the following address, any unused sack tag or crate tag issued to that licence holder.

Penalty

9. Any person who contravenes this Notice is liable to a penalty of 20 penalty units.

2. Under section 17(1C) of the Fisheries Act 1968, the taking of scallops in the waters of Port Phillip Bay is prohibited.
