#### Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981

NOTICE REGARDING THE AMENDMENT,
COMMENCEMENT AND AVAILABILITY
OF THE POISONS CODE

I, Rob Knowles, Minister for Health, give notice that the Poisons Code, prepared under sections 12 and 12E of the **Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981**, will be amended by the incorporation by reference of an amendment to the Commonwealth standard as prescribed by the Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances (Commonwealth Standard) Regulations 1995.

The Poisons Code is a document that enables certain parts of the Commonwealth standard, particularly those parts relating to the uniform scheduling of drugs and poisons, to be incorporated by reference and then applied as law in Victoria.

The Poisons Code will be amended to the extent that earlier incorporated by reference material, being the Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons (SUSDP) No. 11, as amended by SUSDP No. 11 Amendment Nos. 1, 2 Part A, 3 and 4, will be amended,

varied, remade or superseded to the extent necessary by the incorporation by reference of SUSDP No. 12 and SUSDP No. 12, Amendment No. 1.

The date fixed for the amending, varying, remaking or superseding material to take effect is the date on which this notice is published in the Victoria Government Gazette.

#### Planning and Environment Act 1987 PORT PHILLIP PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment L52

The Minister for Planning and Local Government has approved Amendment L52 to the Port Phillip Planning Scheme.
