Upon reading the material tendered in support of this application the Tribunal is satisfied that it is appropriate to grant an exemption from Sections 13, 100 and 195 of the Act to enable the applicant to advertise for and employ Kooris only for the positions of Co-ordinator, 2 Family Workers and a Program Support Worker in the Wanjana Lidj Aboriginal Preservation Service.

In granting this exemption the Tribunal noted:

- Anglicare Gippsland is an agency of Anglicare Victoria which is the welfare arm of the Anglican Church. The organisation was established by the **Anglican Welfare Agency Act 1997**. The agency employs 72 staff and over 150 volunteers to provide welfare and support services that aim to strengthen the Gippsland community.
- The applicant is establishing an Aboriginal Family Preservation Service which is one of three pilot programs to be funded by the Department of Human Services. The Wanjana Lidj Aboriginal Family Preservation Service is being established in conjunction with an advisory committee comprising of local Koori people.

- The service will provide intensive in home, emotional and practical support to families where there is a risk of family breakdown. Specifically the service aims to strengthen the ability of Aboriginal families to protect and care for their at risk children, thereby avoiding child removal and placement.
- The service will be working with families that have a history of involvement by protective services. These families will be in a volatile and vulnerable position and will be mistrustful of outsiders. The Family Workers and Co-ordinator will be working with families in their homes. They will need to become part of the family to understand what is causing the dysfunction, in order to suggest and model appropriate alternatives that will be implemented by client families.
- Going into people's homes and providing information and advice about their family functioning is a highly sensitive issue. It is believed that the Koori people's fear of a welfare system that has caused them significant stress and harm in the past will be a huge barrier to overcome. If the Family Workers and the Co-ordinator are not Aboriginal, it is unlikely that the service will be utilised by the Koori families. To be an effective advocate, which is the key aspect of the Program Support Worker's role, the incumbent will need to have a personal approach which is underpinned by Aboriginal values and principles.
- Employing Aboriginal staff will not only be critical to the effectiveness of the service, but will also provide employment opportunities to the local community which is characterised by high unemployment, drug and alcohol abuse. This will be a positive development that could play an important role in reconciling Koori families and the community as a whole.

The Tribunal grants an exemption from the operation of Sections 13, 100 and 195 of the **Equal Opportunity Act 1995**, to enable the applicant to advertise for and employ Kooris only for the positions of Co-ordinator, 2

Family Workers and a Program Support Worker in the Wanjana Lidj Aboriginal Preservation Service; this exemption to remain in force until 5 November 2000.

some occasions consumers, both male and female, choose to work with a male employment counsellor.

- Having a male counsellor gives the opportunity for role modelling for the male consumers and help to redress the gender imbalance.
