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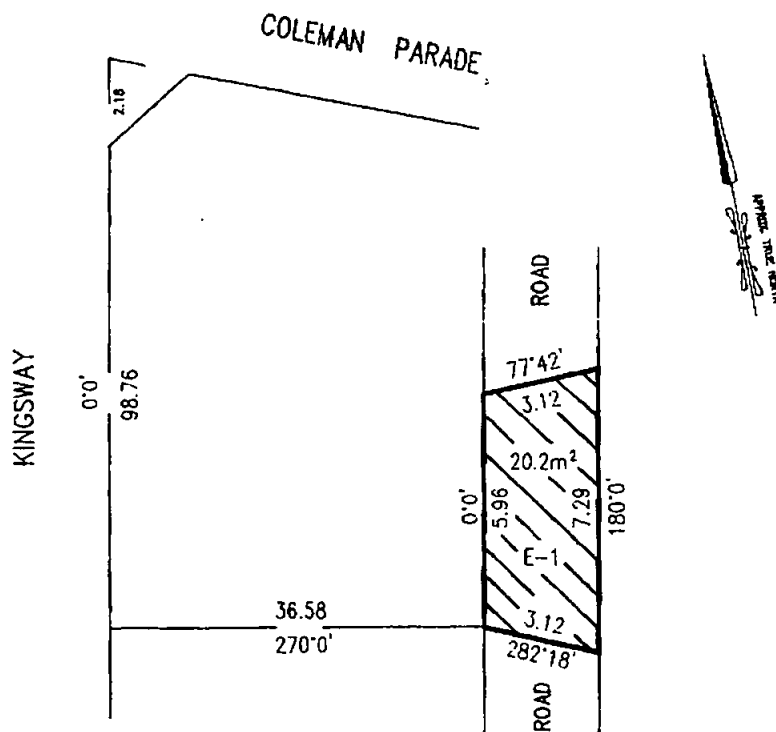

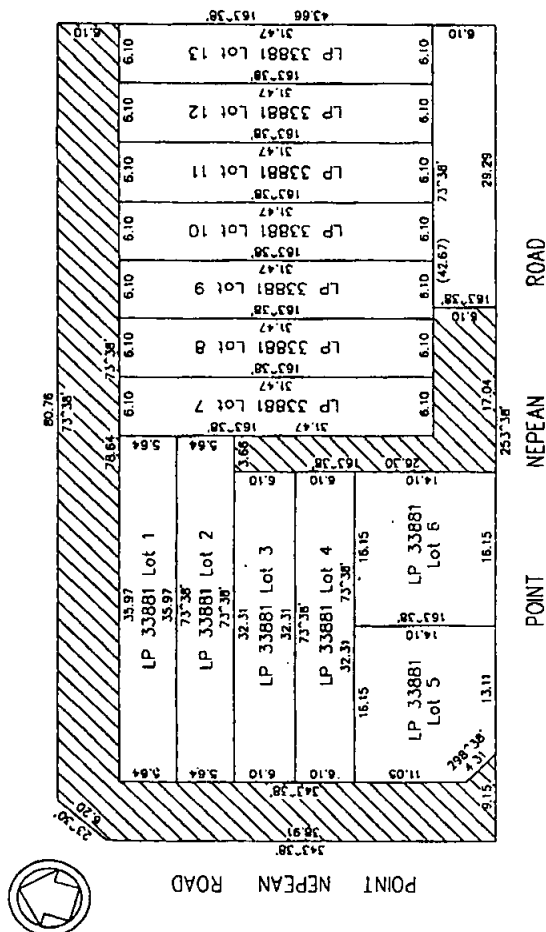


E-1—SEWERAGE EASEMENT IN FAVOUR OF YARRA

DISCONTINUANCE AREA SHOWN HATCHED

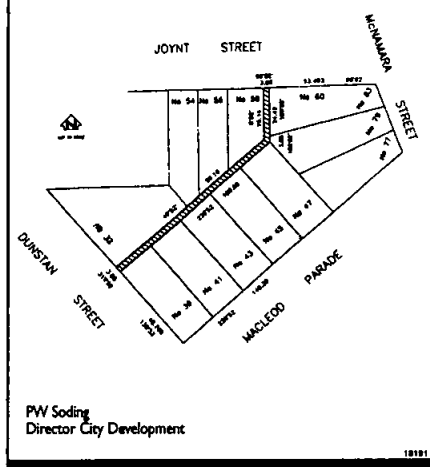

## SCHEDULE 2

## Conditions, Limitations and Restrictions

- (1) Common wombats may be taken or destroyed in the parishes listed in Schedule 1 by a landowner or occupier who is engaged in rural production and by the permanent employees of that landowner or occupier.
- (2) Common wombats may be taken or destroyed by a person specified in Paragraph (1) only by the use of firearms conforming to the specifications in Paragraph (3).
- (3) Wombats may be destroyed only by a centre-fire rifle, fitted with a telescopic sight. The rifle must have a centre-fire case capacity of a least .222 Remington. The ammunition must have an expanding projectile (soft or hollow point) of not less than 324 mg (50 grains) and provide a minimum muzzle energy of 1542 Joules (1137 foot-pounds). Note: .222 Remington with 50 grain projectile must be loaded to achieve a muzzle velocity of 975 m/sec. (3200 ft/sec.) to reach this minimum energy. Standard factory loads conform to this specification.
